Notes from the Chair:

## Now Is the Time For All Good People To Come To the Aid of the Party! PLEASE!

**HELP!** Welcome to the "poverty edition" of *The Utah Liberator*. We want to make it clear that we need money to continue this newsletter. Well-written, interesting, timely articles [not to mention the superb editing and design-ed.] all by volunteers, then printed and delivered by the USPS on their usual cash-in-advance terms. This issue may be the last we can afford.

We even get fan mail from out of state. Plus a check! Our thanks to Connecticut Libertarian Party state chair **CARL E. VASSAR** for his kind thoughts and contribution.

Some have tried to convince me that there are many "pure" Utah Libertarians who are so idealistic that their Libertarian thoughts are sufficient to pay the party's bills. I have tried to believe, but our treasurer tells me the emotional support monies have not increased our account balance. So we're back to a direct appeal for funds.

Perhaps we should start a Utah Torch Club. To qualify for Torch Club status, members would pledge, \$25-50 per month. We would shower them with honors and laurels. Or, a Golden Torch Club could be limited to ten members who pledge \$250 per month. Such an organization would easily support *The Liberator* and our other outreach efforts.

For example, a typical gun show costs about \$75. Sales of books and other merchandise average about \$15 per show. There are four to six gun shows per year. Perhaps we should only work these shows if we have a "Show Sponsor" to front (donate) the expenses?

Up to now, your state officers have been dipping into their own pockets to make sure *The Liberator*

gets published and mailed. However, we are all running out of such ready cash.

Maybe we're not doing the right thing. Please fill out both surveys on p.4 and send them in. Let us know what you want/need us to do. (Heck, even if you don't complete the survey, send money!)

If you haven't yet officially joined the LPUtah, please join today. If you don't feel like joining, subscribe to this newsletter for just \$10. If you're already a member, recruit or recommend someone.

**The Tax Man Can Give:** On April 15th, you can give us a \$1 donation just by checking the box on your Utah Income Tax form to donate Libertarian Party; if you're married, you can check two boxes to contribute two dollars. This does not increase your tax nor decrease your refund. It also means every dollar you give the LPUtah is a dollar less in government waste.

**National Elections:** This election year is going to be a firecracker of fun. The Republican presidential candidates have forgotten the Contract With America and have compromised, as usual, on the budget. The Democrats are still happily committed to the old "New Deal," the "Great Society" and all of the other socialist disasters that are still eating away at the productive strength of the country. What's more, the income tax system is so bad many establishment politicians are in favor of replacements.

**State Elections:** Locally we have the tragicomic case of the grasping goodwife who represents the second congressional district till next January. **Candidates Wanted:** We can't be considered a serious political entity unless we appear on the ballot. ## Let's All Get On The Ballot!

A major goal for 1996 is doubling the number of candidates over the 1994 total. In '94, the LPUtah fielded 30 Libertarian candidates statewide, 18 of whom ran in SL County. In '96, there are 131 partisan races throughout Utah. If we cannot fill out the whole ballot, a reasonable effort would be to recruit and run 60 candidates. On the other hand, if we just double the number of candidates from SLCounty (from 18 to 36), we would fill out the county ballot. In Salt Lake County, there are 31 State House races, four State Senate races, and one County Commission race.

With the filing period upon us, I will be coordinating the SLCounty effort to recruit these candidates. If you are interested in being a candidate, please let me know so I can focus on those races where we still need to place candidates on the ballot.

If you consider running for an office or recruiting someone else to run, keep in mind that it's just as important to recruit a campaign manager, or assistant, for each candidate. Some candidates may already have a friend or associate willing to help, but our candidates need support, including direct involvement in their campaigns and getting out votes.

Everyone is encouraged to run and to help recruit additional candidates, but please keep me informed so I can help coordinate the overall picture. If I can help you with information that will help you recruit candidates, let me know (801/359-8551 or mood@xmission.com).

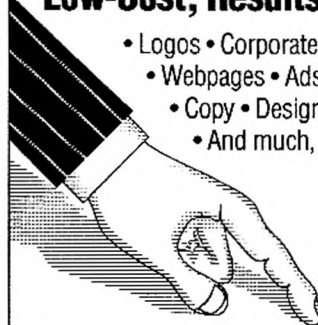
