SAVADEL ASSAILS SALES TAX INCREASE

Speaking before a group of about 50 people yesterday, Richard Savadel, candidate for State Senate, 5th district, criticized the Republicans for their pushing through a sales tax increase despite the opposition of the residents of Nassau County.

"Rather than raise taxes to balance larger budgets, the size of government should be reduced to fit the revenues. The politicians tell you they need the sales tax increase so that the property tax won't go up. But next year they will raise the property taxes anyway.

"The Nassau County budget is far from being skin and bones. There is an abundance of fat, and I prescribe a diet of reduced taxes to eliminate government waste of your hard earned money."

Mr. Savadel also spoke against public housing: "Public housing is a disaster area. The government is inefficient and corrupt when building houses, as well as in other areas.

The government destroys neighborhoods by condemnation, and then put up houses that the former residents of the area cannot afford to buy. Leave the providing of decent housing to private industry, which will build homes that people can afford, in areas where they want to live, without displacing the people who already live there.

The occasion for the gathering was a cocktail party for people to meet Mr. Savadel, Libertarian candidate for State Senate, and Martin Nixon, U.S. Senate candidate of the Free Libertarian Party.

Mr. Nixon said that government has spread to areas far beyond its original purpose. "It is wrong for the government to tell people how to run their lives. There should be no laws against gambling, owning guns, prostitution, taking drugs, etc. Your life is to do with as you wish, as long as you do not violate other's rights in the process."
