The Cross depicted in this photograph is a temporary memorial only, and will be replaced by a permanent memorial when opportunity permits, which you may be sure, will be in keeping with the gallant sacrifice of our men.

Special units, whose duty it is to keep all War Graves in good order for all time, have been formed, and I trust that it will be some consolation to you to know that the grave of your loved one will be carefully maintained in a manner befitting one who has given his life in the service of the Allied Cause.
