

Lenski Reloadable King Soopers Card Frequently Asked Questions



1. What is the benefit to Lenski of these new reloadable cards?

Lenski will receive 5% of the total sale each time you reload your card. In addition, the opportunity for Lenski to earn money is not limited to the school months. Your card is good throughout the year, including the summer.

2. What is the benefit to me for purchasing a new reloadable card?

Once you've purchased your card, it can be used again and again. There will be no need to send in monthly forms or stop by our Lobby Sales to purchase cards. Having and using this card doesn't cost you anything, we all have to go to the grocery store and Lenski receives 5% of every total purchase made with this card. What could be easier?

3. How do I reload my card?

Cards can be reloaded at the customer service desk or with a cashier. There's a 5 minute delay before the card becomes active. We recommend you reload your card **upon entering the store**. If you don't have enough money on your card to cover your purchases, you'll have to reload the card in a separate transaction that, because of the delay, cannot be applied to the balance of the day's purchases.

4. Can family members use the reloadable card?

Yes! We encourage you to buy reloadable cards for your spouse, grandparents, family members, and friends who would like to support Lenski. The cards we sell are coded specifically for our school, so anyone can use them and Lenski will benefit.

5. What if I lose my card?

King Soopers cannot be responsible for the card value if a card is lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed. A new card may be purchased from the **Grocery--Same as Cash Card** team in order for it to be linked to our fundraising program. You CANNOT purchase a Lenski reloadable King Soopers card at the store.

6. What if I forget to reload my King Soopers card?

Cards with a zero balance for 90 days become inactive, and you'll need to purchase a new card from the Grocery-Same as Cash card team.

7. What if I haven't used my King Soopers card during the summer months?

If it's been more than 90 days since you last used your card, it has become inactive. You'll simply need to purchase a new card from the Grocery-Same as Cash card team.
