Attention Parents: Important information on H1N1 Vaccine

- The H1N1 (swine Flu) vaccination permission slips were distributed home on Monday, November 9th via your child's backpack.
- Please read all the Vaccination Information Sheets and fill out a permission slip for either Flumist (yellow sheet) or Flu shot (green sheet). One permission sheet per child. If you decline the vaccination, you do not need to fill out any forms.
- Permission slips are due THIS FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 13th, 2009 and are to be RETURNED TO THE BOARD OF HEALTH LOCATED IN THE TOWN HALL.
- If your child was absent Monday, November 9th and did not receive the vaccination forms, you may pick them up at the main office this week.
- Actual Flu clinic date: TBA
- If your child has had the "presumed H1N1 virus" or flu like symptoms recently, the Board of Health and Department of Public Health are recommending that you still vaccinate your child against the H1N1 virus. There were many cases that were not 100% confirmed or diagnosed as H1N1, and the virus may return or mutate this winter.
