1. INDIVIDUAL PAGES

Enclosed is the template for each student's individual page. On the back of this page are several samples if you need some ideas to get started. The large rectangle should be filled with photos and/or drawings. The rectangle will be scanned in color exactly as it is, so please stay within the boundaries. PLEASE BE AS CREATIVE AND COLORFUL AS POSSIBLE! Students, write in your answers to the questions at the top of the page (we'll type them in for the final product). Also, please give us your best signature and we'll include that in the yearbook as well.

2. KINDERGARTEN AND 5TH GRADE PHOTOS

Please send us a kindergarten photo of your child so we can have both then and now. We will be receiving 5th grade photos from the class photographer. If for any reason you don't want to use this year's photo or you missed picture days, please send us a 5th grade photo too.

3. 5th GRADE ACTIVITY PHOTOS

We know many of you have been taking pictures at the fun 5th grade activities this year. Now is the time to get those photos to us!

4. "THROUGH THE YEARS" PHOTOS

Please collect photos of our 5th graders throughout their many years at Lincoln. Try especially hard to collect "group" photos. These are used to create collage pages that are often the most fun ones of the yearbook!

You can email photos to lspaceix@gmail.com anytime. Be sure to include your name, the names of the children in the photo, and (if appropriate) the name of the event. We prefer digital photos, which save us the work of returning physical ones. You can also give pictures to us on USB stick, SD card, or disc. If you have physical pictures and do not have a scanner, please be sure to put return information on the back of each photo. Photos can only be returned if return information is provided.

Completed individual pages and kindergarten photos are due after vacation week, by Friday, March 4.

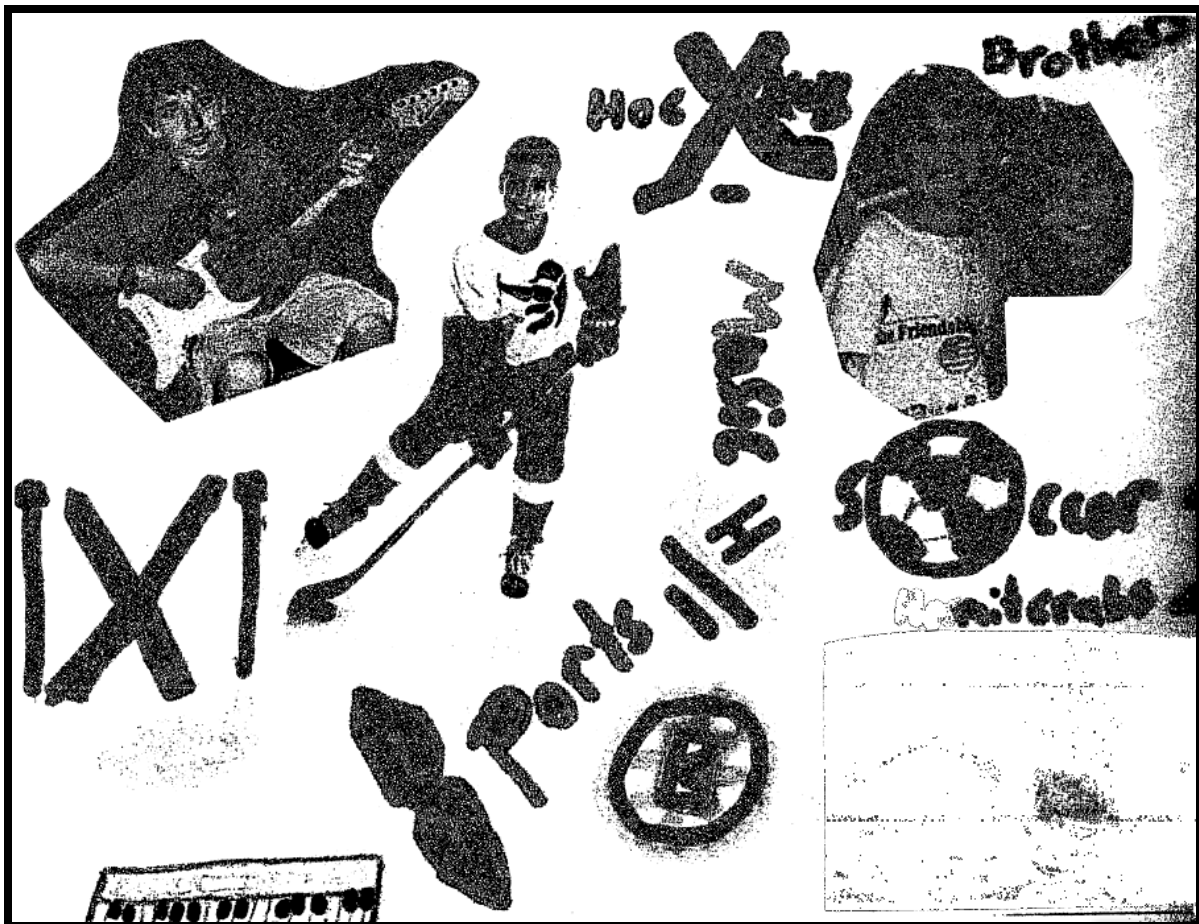
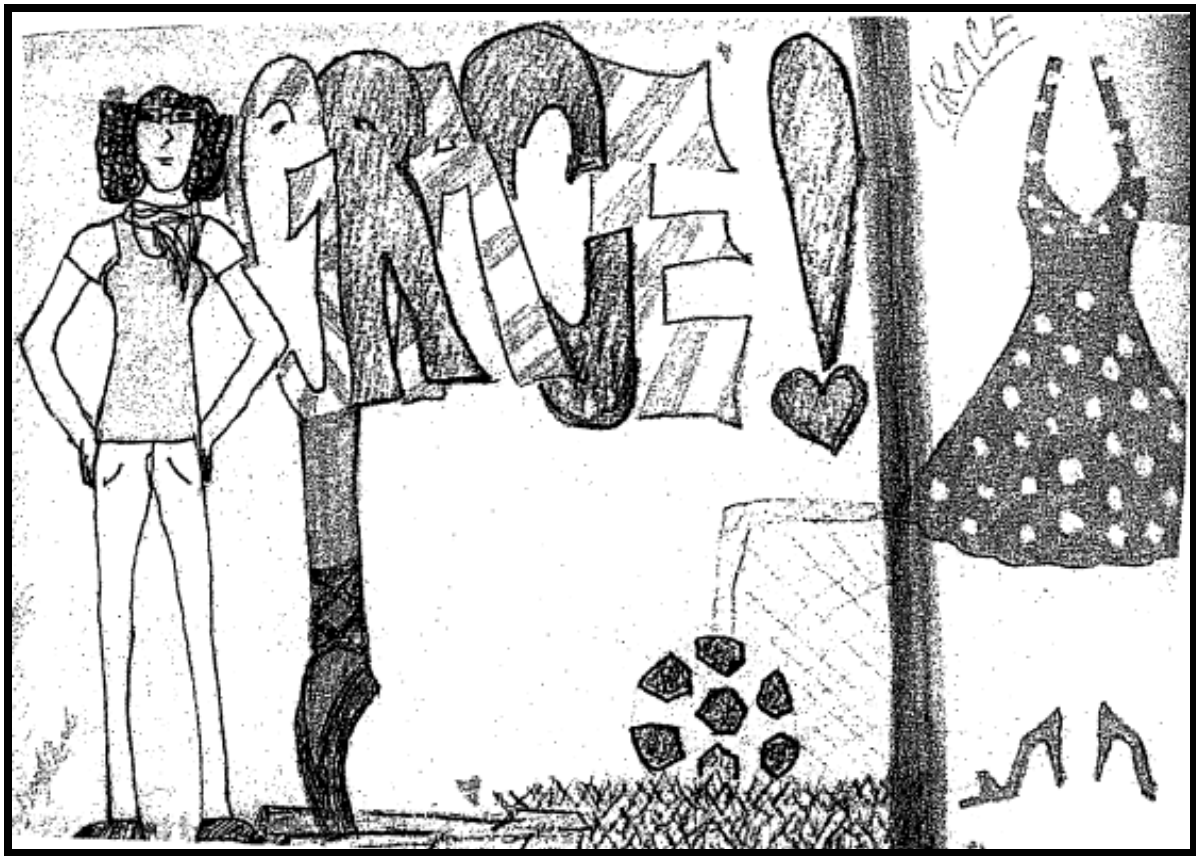
Your 5th Grade Activity and "Through the Years" photos due at the same time, by Friday, March 4.
