



# *Field Day*

## *Friday, June 5*

*A Treasured tradition at Lincoln*

*Ready to have a Ball? It's time to start thinking about Field Day. With Manchester Field under construction, there have been questions as to how the day will run. Here's an overview of the day, as well as a pitch to recruit more help!*

*Just before 9:00 am, grades K-2 will go to Manchester Field with their teachers and cycle through a number of stations, playing games such as Egg on a Spoon, Sponge Relay, 3-legged race, Water Balloon Toss, Shuttle Run, etc. The children will stay with their class and teacher the entire time. All students are encouraged, but not forced, to participate. They will return to Lincoln at 11:00 for lunch. Dismissal time is the regular 12:15 pm for Kindergarten and 2:35 pm for grades 1-5. After lunch, grades 1-2 will remain at Lincoln until dismissal, playing kickball, hearing a story, watching a clip on sportsmanship and doing yoga! For grades 3-5, they will have a similar day as 1-2, but will start the day at Lincoln and be at Manchester Field in the afternoon..*

*So, here's what's needed:*

*The popular option is buying a pizza lunch (includes: slice of Gloria's cheese pizza, pretzels, carrot sticks and dip, watermelon slices, a drink and Italian ice), which is offered through the school. **Please let your teacher know by Thursday, May 28th if a lunch will be purchased on field day.** Your child will need to bring a lunch ticket on 6/5 if pizza is wanted - otherwise pack a bagged lunch. Popsicles will be served on the field. For parents volunteering, you may purchase a lunch for \$4 - cash only.*

*What to wear?*

*Comfortable clothing. Each student will be assigned a shirt color so teams can be assigned easily on the fields. Your teacher will be communicating this as the date gets closer.*

*Sunscreen is recommended, as well as a hat, sneakers (no crocks, sandals, or cleats) and a water bottle (we recommend putting a name on it).*

*Lastly, come join the fun! Field Day wouldn't happen without the help of many parents.
