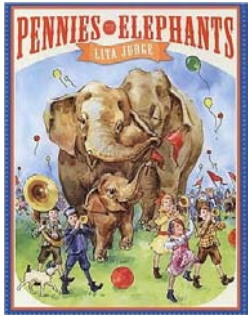

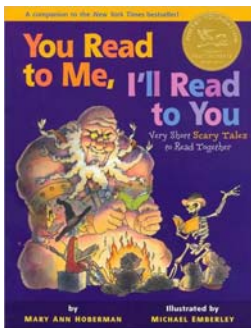


Pennies For Elephants

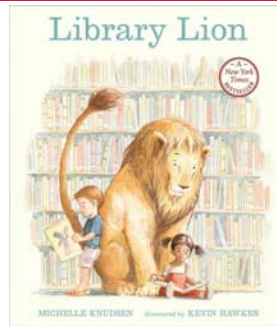


You Read to Me, I'll Read to You

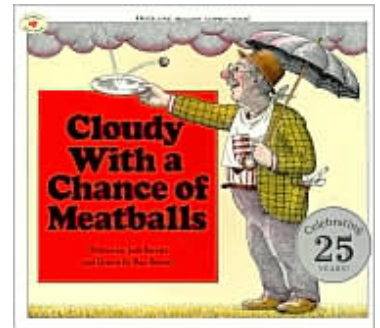


Library Lion

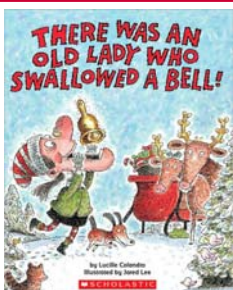


Cloudy With a Chance of Meatballs

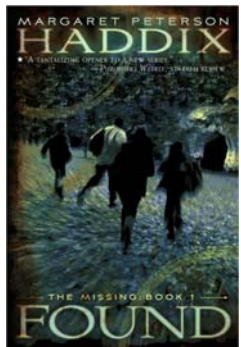
The Lemonade War

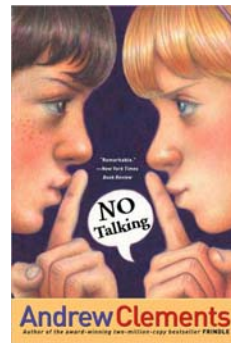
The Missing Book 1 Found

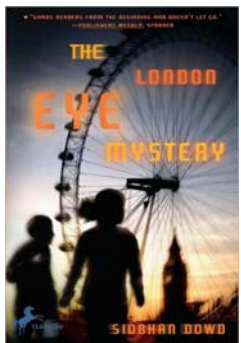


No Talking

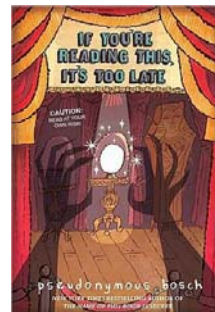
The London Eye Mystery

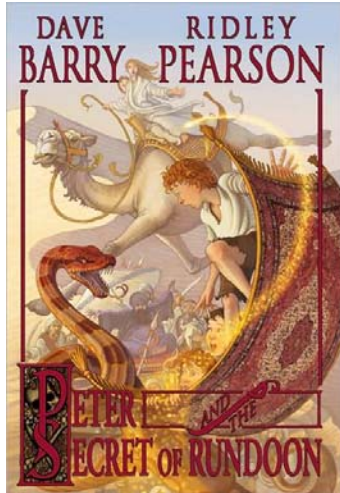
If You're Reading This It's Too Late

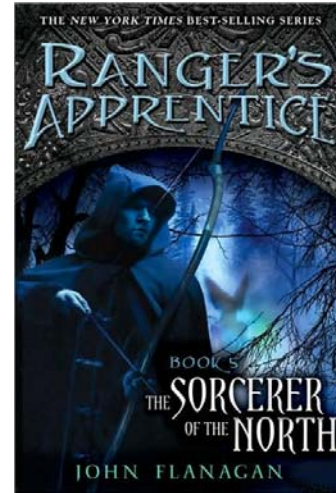


Peter and the Secret of Rundoon

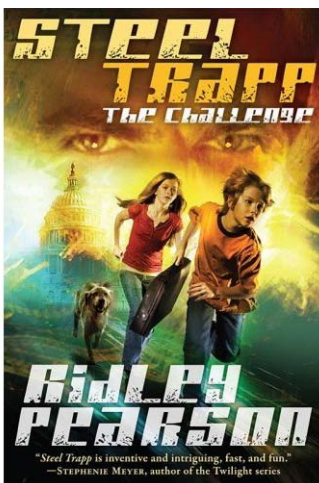


Ranger's Apprentice 05 The Sorcerer of the North

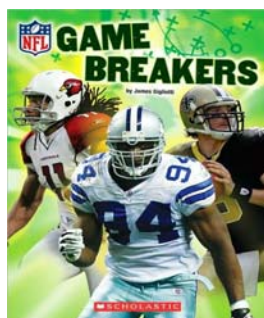


Coraline Graphic Novel

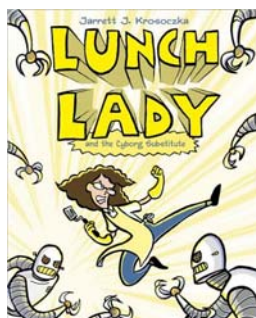


Game Breakers
