Procedures

Cancellations: Each class has a minimum and maximum number of students. If the minimum is not met, the class will be canceled. Classes which do not meet the minimum enrollment will be canceled as of **May 15th**. Parents will be notified promptly and refunds will be sent at this time.

Grades: All grade levels indicate the child's grade as of fall 2010.

Locations: All courses will occur in Winchester school buildings. Based upon which courses run, optimal building usage and course needs will determine where courses occur.

Refunds: Refunds will be made if the class does not enroll its minimum number by May 15, or if a teacher is unable to offer the course.

Food: For half day programs, bring a snack. For full day, bring snack and lunch.

Due to popular demand, Lego Robotics is back for the 2010 Summer Enrichment Program. We know this combination of hands-on learning and problem solving paired with cooperative movement games will provide your learns with the opportunity to exercise both mind and body. Last summer the program was more than successful with a great student turn out also with fantastic parent /student feedback.

Lego Robotics: The students will explore the wonderful world of Lego's through robotics. Through hands on learning activities with Lego's, children will begin to be exposed to the Engineering Process. Over the course of the week, students will problem solve and create to build solutions to a necessary task or given problems. As students progress, they will work with motors and sensors to power their Lego structure. Students will even write their own computer programs to command their creations!

Sports and More: The students will have a chance to experience cooperative, problem solving, strategy, implementation and competitive games in noncompetitive situations. The primary focus of each session of Sports and More centers around team building through movement based activities. The concept of "everyone wins when they give 100% effort with their athletic skills as well as their ability to work well with each others" is truly discussed throughout each session. At the end of the session, the students will sit down and participate in a "feedback session" where they will review what went well and what the students can take to work on during the next session. "Open Circle" ideas and theories will be integrated throughout all of the sessions. The goal for every student is to increase self confidence and self-awareness through the participation in non-threatening sports based activities.
