Introduction (5 pts) rapport, attention, purpose	Introduction establishes rapport with and/or catches the interest of audience immediately and describes the purpose of the presentation (5 pts)	Introduction missing one of the following elements: establishes rapport with the audience, catches the interest of audience immediately, or describes the purpose of the presentation (3-4 pts)	Introduction fails to establish rapport with and/or catch the interest of audience immediately and does not effectively describe the purpose of the presentation (0-2 pts)	/5
Content (15 pts) (meaningful, useful and achieved objectives)	Information included in the presentation displays a superior level of preparedness, organization, and attention to detail; transitions between topics or pages are smooth and effective (15 pts)	Information included in the presentation displays a moderate level preparedness, organization, and attention to detail; transitions between topics or pages could be more effective (10-14 pts)	Information included in the presentation displays a minimal level preparedness, organization, and attention to detail; transitions between topics or pages mainly ineffective (0-9 pts)	/15
Conclusion (5 pts) (How will you reinforce your topic at its end?)	Conclusion clearly and concisely summarizes and concludes the presentation, expresses gratitude to the audience, and asks for questions—only if appropriate (5 pts)	Conclusion summarizes and concludes the presentation, expresses gratitude to the audience, and asks for questions—only if appropriate (3-4 pts)	Conclusion lacks clarity or summary, does not express gratitude or is disingenuous (0-2 pts)	/5
Class Presence (15 pts) <i>Verbal effectiveness</i> (use of pauses, filler words (uh, um, OK, etc), tone(enthusiastic or interested in topic), volume (not too loud or too soft), pitch (making sure everyone in room can hear) and pacing (speaking slow or fast <i>Body Languages (gestures, eye contact, posture)</i>	Effective use of voice tone, volume, pitch and pacing; no use of filler words and appropriate use of pauses; Effective use of body language (appropriate gestures, continuous eye contact with entire audience, confident, audience facing posture) (15 pts)	Moderately effective use of voice tone, volume, pitch and pacing; some use of filler words and appropriate use of pauses; Moderately effective use of body language (some gestures inappropriate, some intermittent eye contact or eye contact with only some audience members, posture sometimes lacked confidence or faced away from audience) (10-14 pts)	Minimally effective use of voice tone, volume, pitch and pacing; excessive use of filler words and inappropriate use of pauses; Minimally effective use of body language (inappropriate gestures, lack of eye contact with audience or contact w/ just one or a few members, posture lacked confidence and/or faced away from audience) (0-9 pts)	/15
