

Homework Choices for Vocabulary Review

Using at least twenty new vocabulary words from the unit's vocabulary, do the following:

Choose at least **ONE** of the following:

- Design a crossword puzzle or a word search with clues in English and a key provided
- Use each of the vocabulary words in a sentence not found in class handouts (must be original)
- Write a postcard or note to a friend
- Make a recording in which you read the vocabulary word, pronouncing it correctly, followed by the English equivalent

And any **TWO** of the following:

- Make flashcards with a colored picture on one side, and the vocabulary word on the other side. Pictures may be original or cut out.
- Make a poster, a collage, or hanging mobile with vocabulary words illustrated and labeled. OR make a word wall using "Wordle" and email the teacher its embed code. (Ask me for the instructions.)
- Draw a cartoon (or design one online - ask Mrs. Shackelford for information) using vocabulary words as either dialogue or picture labels
- Write a short story and read it on tape
- Make a board game using vocabulary from the chapter
- Write a song or a rap (and perform it)
- Make a scrapbook or booklet of pictures illustrating vocabulary, labeled correctly
- Make a video in which vocabulary is shown and the words are also spoken

The items described are homework, and you must specify to me ahead of time what type of activities you will do.
