



## Technical Requirements: Children's Progress Academic Assessment (CPAA)

*All CPAA reports are web-based and accessible immediately from any computer with internet access. The requirements below apply to the installation-based version of the assessment software; a BETA browser-based version of the assessment software will be available for Fall 2012.*

<b>Operating System</b>	Windows 2000 or later; Mac OS X 10.4.11 or later
<b>Processor Speed</b>	1 Ghz
<b>RAM</b>	<b>Minimum:</b> 512 MB; <b>Recommended:</b> 1 GB
<b>Required Disk Space</b>	Up to 300 MB
<b>Browser</b>	Cookies & Javascript must be enabled <b>Minimum:</b> Firefox 3.0+. Internet Explorer 6.1+, Safari 3.0+ <b>Recommended:</b> Firefox 3.0+. Internet Explorer 8.0+, Safari 3.0+

<b>Internet Connectivity</b>	High-speed broadband internet connection. (In a computer lab of 20 students, we recommend a minimum steady upload & download speed of 128kB/s. A typical T1 line provides ~193kB/s upload & download speeds and can be expected to allow for a glitch-free administration for a lab of 20 students.)
<b>Necessary Peripherals</b>	Keyboard, mouse, headphones
