

# Running Basic NWEA Reports

## **Types of Reports (6):**

1. Next-day overall summary results *\*suggested for 1<sup>st</sup> year in MAP testing*
  - a. Online Reports- Teacher Report- Select Term- Open in PDF
2. Individual Student Progress Report
  - a. Online Report- Class Rosters- Select Term- Modify results as wanted- click on a student
    - i. \*for an individual report
    - ii. or click on the 'class' beside 'class name' for reports for the ENTIRE class
3. Students Grouped into RIT Score Ranges
  - a. Instructional Resources- Class by RIT- select term & class- submit
    - i. \*may print PDF, or click on the subject and then indicators for further breakdown!
      1. It shows the "Goal Strand" AND Breaks the indicator into SPECIFIC content goals
    - ii. \*\*click on a student's name for specific DesCartes break-down
      1. lower column RIT range is mastered (75% correct)
      2. middle column RIT range is the student's CURRENT learning level (50% correct)
      3. upper column RIT range is extension (25% correct)

4. Teacher/Class Overview (graphed)
  - a. Dynamic Tools- Dynamic Reports (Teacher overview is default)
    - i. Goals and grade by RIT Band
    - ii. May also bring up student reading range, and student suggested booklist from this report
    - iii. Also, student projected performance
      1. From Default Summary Page- Click on 'projected performance' above bar graphs
        - a. Below standards (below 40%)
        - b. Proficient (40% or above)
        - c. Advanced (70% or above)
    - iv. Student goal setting worksheet
      1. From Default Summary Page- Click on 'Student Goal Setting Worksheet'
        - a. Individual summary
        - b. Goal setting opportunities
