

Mr. O'Brien's Assignment Rubric

Here's the deal for organizing your unit's assignments to be turned in on test day:

Complete & Check: Make sure each assignment is finished and checked (with ✓'s and/or ✕'s).

Correct: Correct each error by reworking the problem in a different color. If the problem does not require re-working, jot a note explaining your error. Remember- all answers are available, and I will help you do any problem you can't do on your own.

Organize & Staple: Arrange assignments in order (**oldest** assignment on top) with the revision day cover sheet on top. Make sure each assignment is labeled with name, date, number, and assignment. Don't forget to indicate who you worked with! Staple in the **lower right hand corner**.

Your assignment packet will be graded on the following rubric:
