Nursery Rhyme or Book	Activity	Materials
There was an Old Woman - pg. 8-12 (5-8 minutes)	I. Graph # of people in house; sort & classify shoes + make a pattern. II. Role play senses – give each group a sense (better with a different rhyme?)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ice Trays, counters• Index card with each sense written down
Humpty Dumpty – pg. 70-71 (10 minutes)	I. Properties of Eggs - Discussion II. Egg Toss – 3 member teams	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Egg, newspaper, doll, poster sheets + post-its• Plastic eggs, ice trays
<i>The Napping House</i> (15 minutes)	Shutter fold paper and sketch number of feet in house or use stickers. – put the # of feet on the outside of your doors.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 sheet of paper per person• Art supplies for drawing
Jack Be Nimble – pg. 96-99 (10 minutes)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Discuss properties of candles, how do they change when the candle is lit? sort by size, color, texture, or weight. Sort but don't tell how.*• Birthday graphs – made with people – also demo using post-its to create graphs (use with place born)• Paper Airplane – which one can go farthest? – discuss speed and distance	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Candles – all different kinds or just one• Poster sheets + small post-its (graphing), Copies of b-day cakes months.• Piece of paper for airplanes
Mary, Mary Quite contrary pg. 83 (5-8 minutes)	Shell Tell – Math 1. Draw sets of dots on front and write corresponding numerals inside. 2. Write Number words on front and matching numerals inside 3. write math facts on front and answers inside 4. write a series with a blank (such as 1, 2, __, 4, 5.) Children guess and write missing #.	Paper plates + markers or Stickers

*Sorting activity – arrange into 2 groups based upon a property, but don't tell them the property – they have to figure it out. Ss can practice this as well. Can use with Humpty Dumpty as well.

*Role play senses – works with numerous nursery rhymes.
