* **p. 295: Confidential vs. Anonymous**

- Confidential: subjects names are known, but we keep data about patients confidential
- Anonymous: subjects names are unknown.
can prevent follow up

* **p. 297: Clinical Trials**

- Pose risks to patients
- Benefits really only seen by future patients.
- Medical ethics and International human rights standards must be adhered to.
- Interests of the subjects must always prevail over the interest of science & society.
