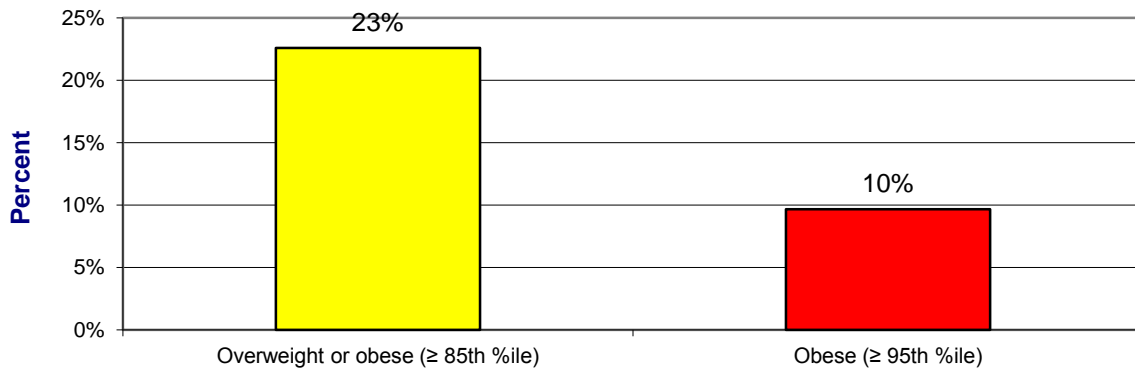

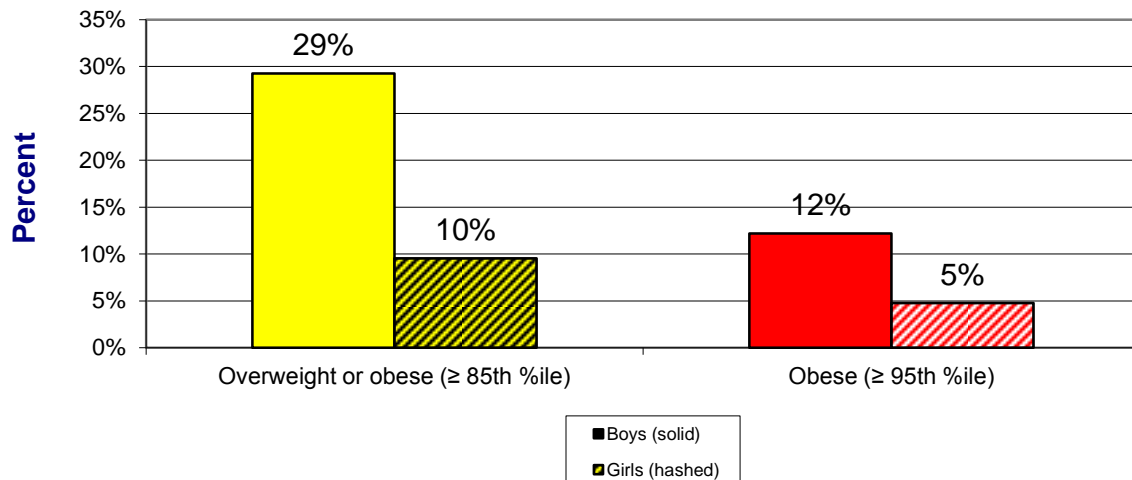

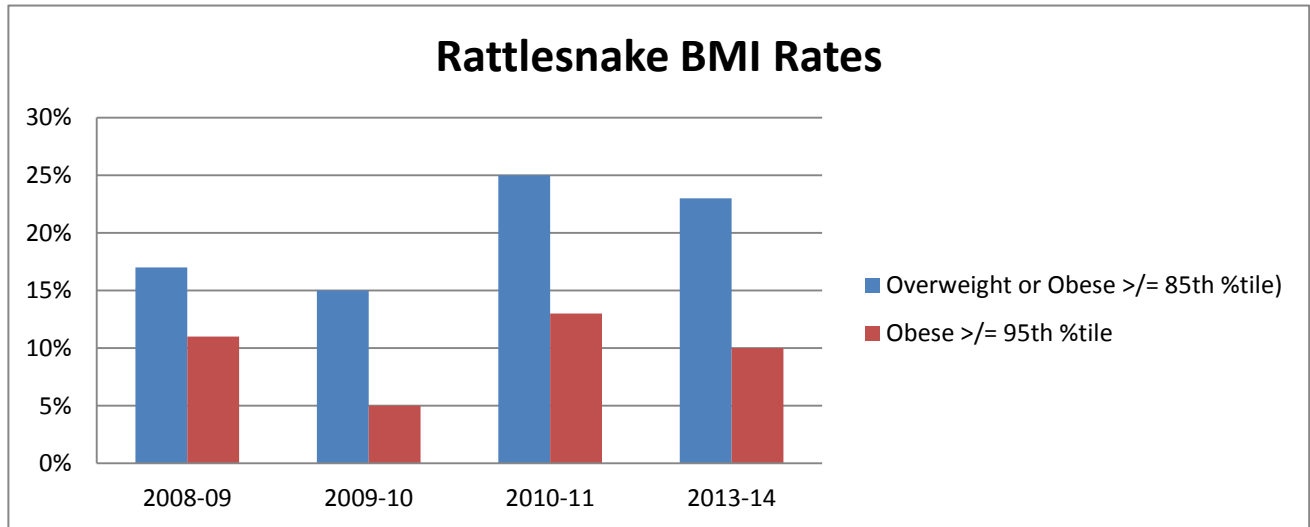
Prevalence of Overweight and Obesity



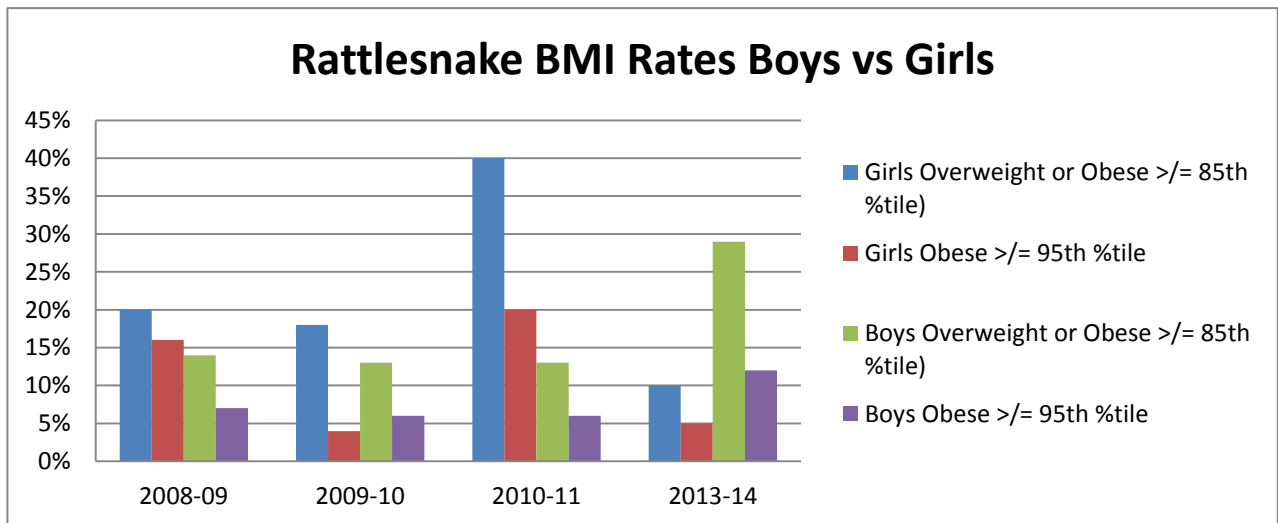
Prevalence of Overweight and Obesity, by Sex
