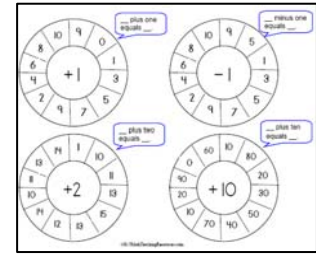
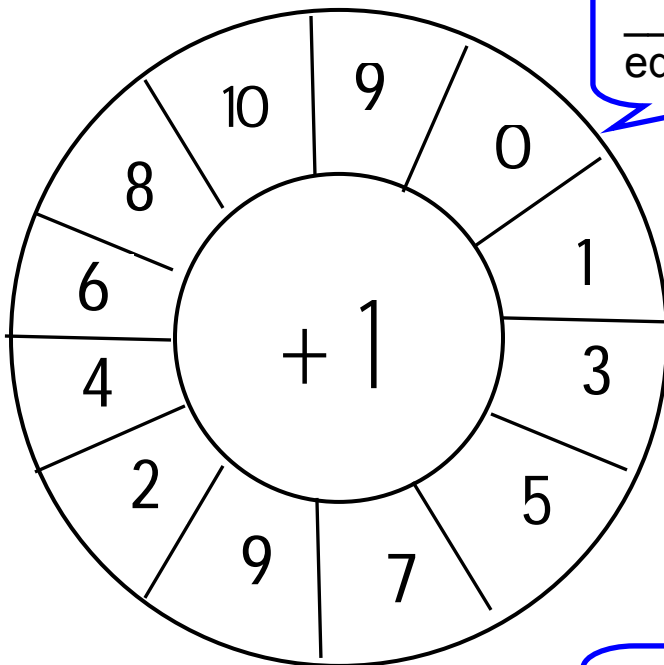


Number Wheel Spin

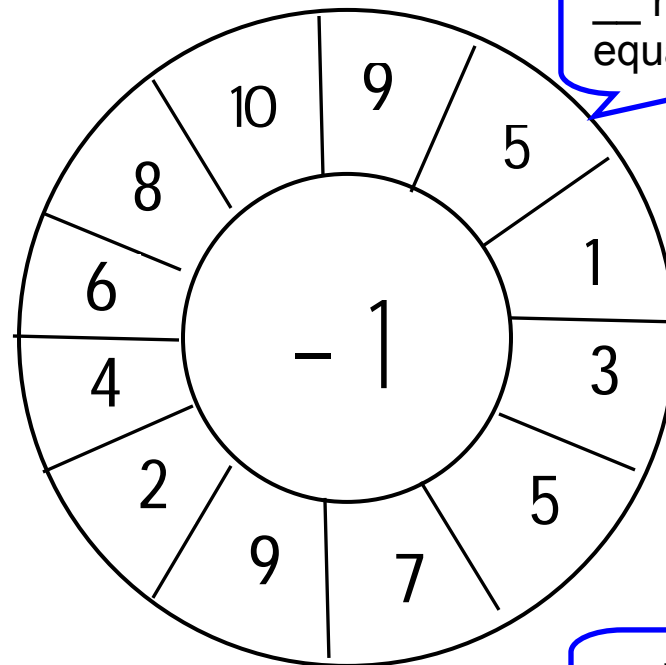
Materials: paperclip, pencils, paper, calculator (optional), Number Wheel Spin board



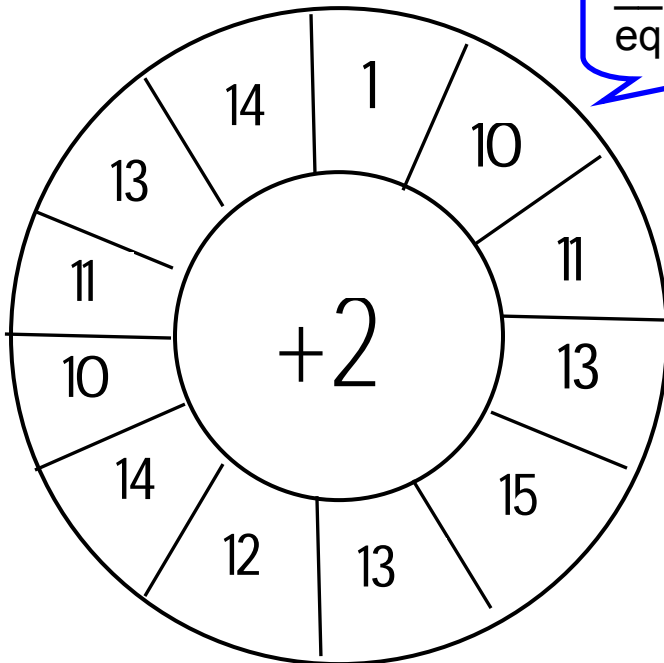
1. Decide which Number Wheel on the board you will both use. Use a pencil and a paper clip to make a spinner on the Number Wheel you choose.
2. Take turns to be the “Spinner” and the Checker.” The Spinner spins the paper clip and completes the math talk sentence. If the paper clip points to more than one number use the smaller number.
3. The Spinner records his/her number sentence on a sheet of paper. The Checker checks the Spinner’s work (the Checker may use a calculator if needed).
4. If the number sentence is correct, the Spinner circles it. If the number sentence is incorrect, the Spinner corrects it but does not circle it.
5. Keep taking turns until you have both have five number sentences. Next, you must both find the sum of your circled scores (use a calculator if you need to).
6. The player with the greater total wins.



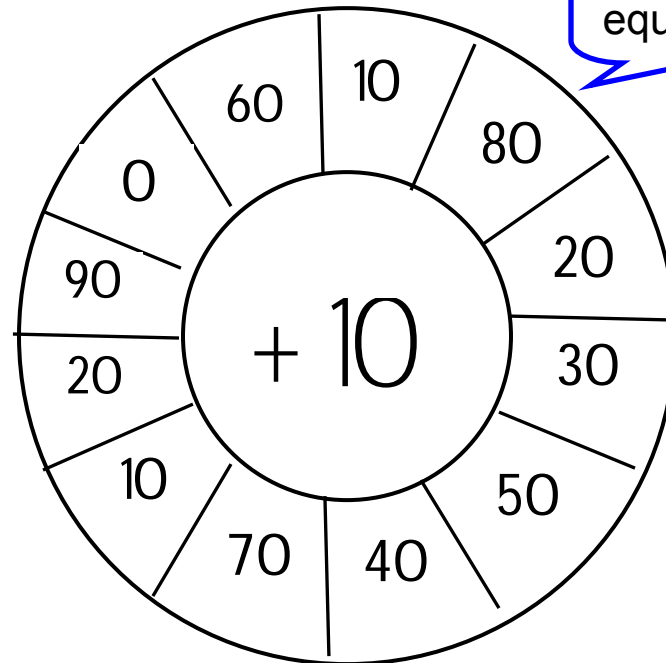
