You and your research team (2 people per group) work in Washington DC at the Center for Disease Control (CDC). It is your BIG DAY because Congress has decided to hear your team's presentation on the disease that you have been researching for some time now. Your task is to gather your information and write a report to present to Congress.

Congress has set guidelines for your team to follow. This is to ensure that all the information is covered and done in the right format before presenting on Capital Hill. These guidelines are as follows:

FORMAT FOR PAPER

- Cover page [include disease name, team members names, class period, and date ONLY].
- Report has to be 2 – 3 pages long, double spaced, size 12 Times New Roman font and typed.
- Report has to have 3 references [at least 1 reference has to be from a hard copy].
- Works Cited or Resource Page

INFORMATION TO INCLUDE IN PAPER

- Define and explain the disease
- Is the disease communicable/non-communicable
- Describe how a person becomes infected with the disease
- Describe the symptoms and how long before symptoms appear
- Describe any treatments
- Describe any tests or diagnosis
- What risk factors **increase** the risk for acquiring the disease
- Any possible alternative medicines/remedies

INFORMATION TO INCLUDE IN POWERPOINT

- Define and explain the disease
- How does a person get infected with the disease?
- Symptoms and treatments of the disease
- Explanation/History of the disease
- Describe any tests or diagnosis
- What risk factors **increase** the risk for acquiring the disease
- Any other interesting facts/pictures about the disease
- 3 true/false questions with answers about the disease
