

Drug Brochure/Poster

Requirements:

1. Drug name and category must be on front cover (Stimulant, Depressant, Hallucinogen or Narcotic)
2. Your name must be on the brochure.
3. One of the following two statements must be included:
“All drugs can be addictive if abused,” or “Using drugs just covers up the real problem, it returns even worse than it was.”
4. At least 2 resources must be cited.
5. At least 3 alternative names or “street names” must be shown.
6. At least 4 names and phone numbers for hotlines to get help information
7. At least 4 statements of additional information that you think are important for your brochure
8. At least 4 forms, methods or ways that the drug can be taken or used (e.g., smoked, ingested, injected/ pill, capsule, powder/ brewed, pipe, cigarette)
9. At least 4 negative effects that the drug has on the body and brain
10. At least 4 sentences on how the drug originated and how it is being used today.
11. Teacher’s interpretation of the quality of the brochure
