MUSTANGS IN ACTION

TRADITION

The Mustangs finished the 2011-2012 season with a record of 21-5 (.807) and advanced to the Elite Eight of the 3A state tournament in Fort Collins. The Mustangs set school records for most wins in a season and are continually one of the best shooting teams in the Tri-Peaks League. The Mustangs also set a record for fewest points allowed per game, holding opponents to just 46.1 PPG. Coach Vecchio has amassed over 400 career wins and guided the Mustangs to eleven state tournament appearances, including six of the last seven seasons. Vecchio was named Tri-Peaks League Coach of the Year in 2012 and the Mustangs had five all-conference players and two all-state players.
