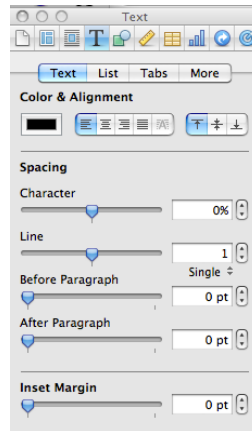


PAGES POSTER PROJECT: Description of this project.

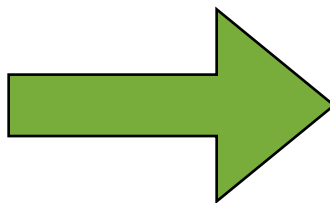
- You will use iWork **Pages** make a poster about someone **FAMOUS** that you admire.
- You must be able to find information online about your subject. You will also create a bibliography using **Easybib.com**, the bibliography will disclose the sources of your information.
- Tips: Use the Inspector on your tool bar to format your FONT (text). The Inspector looks like this:



The text inspector looks like this:



- To quickly save a picture: Select an area of an image or page to take a screen shot and save it to your desktop by holding down Command-Shift-4 at the same time. When the cursor turns into a crosshair + drag the cursor to select the area you want saved.
- To add a Picture *saved on your computer*, select Insert from the menu above, then choose, or select the Media icon next to the Inspector.
- Use Instant Alpha to remove the background



Select Format on the menu

Select Instant Alpha. When your cursor turns into a crosshair + select the colored areas that you want to remove and drag outward. If you over do it, use Command Z keyboard shortcut to undo. You may have to do this a few times to remove all of the background. Try Mask With Shape on the Format Menu to do this:

Select your object, Go to Format, Mask with Shape, Drag the shape or image until your picture is centered within the shape the way you like.

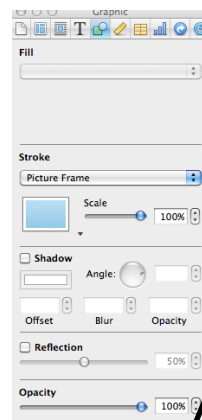


Now MAKE THAT POSTER!

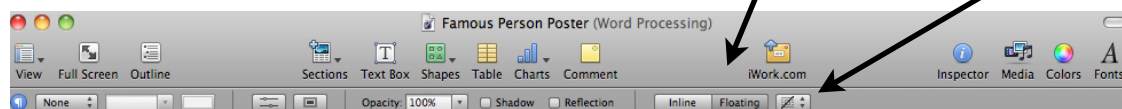
Your poster should include:

- *Fonts that are pleasing and add to the style of the poster (color and style).*
- *Minimum of **three** pictures*
- *Their Name and Job, Skill or Talent*
- *Why this person is famous or what they have done to become famous.*
- *Three **Key Quotes** from this person or about this person*
- *An original slogan **THAT YOU CREATE** that reflects why this person is admirable in your opinion*
- *A bibliography made in **Easybib.com** citing all of your sources of information*
 - *Try to find information that you can cite in Easybib from:*
 - *One Website (think fan sites or marketing sites)*
 - *One News Article, Interview or Press Release*
 - *One Photograph*

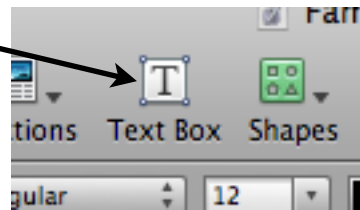
Try adding an outline or Picture Frame to your images. (Inspector - Graphics Manager)
Type to enter text.



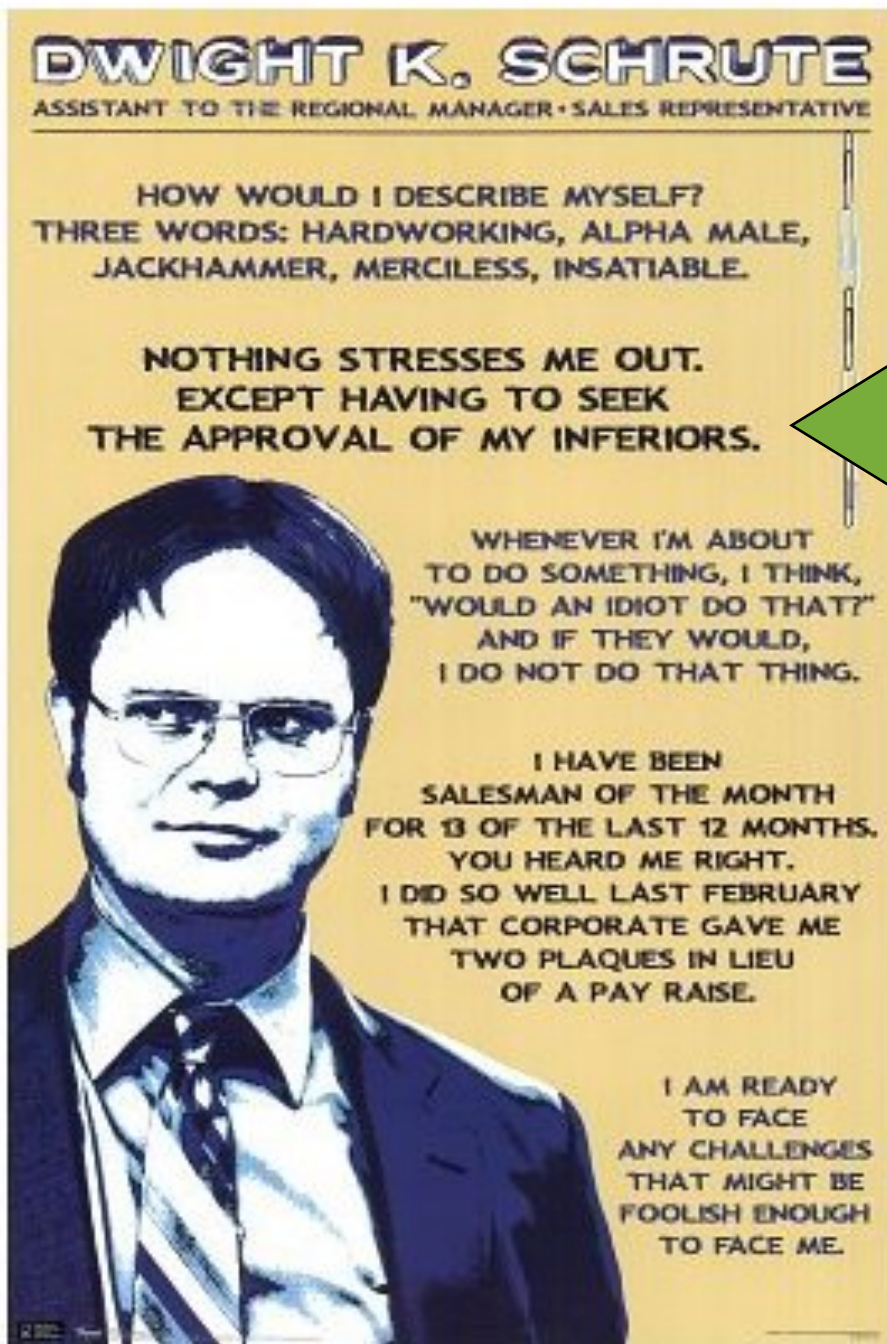
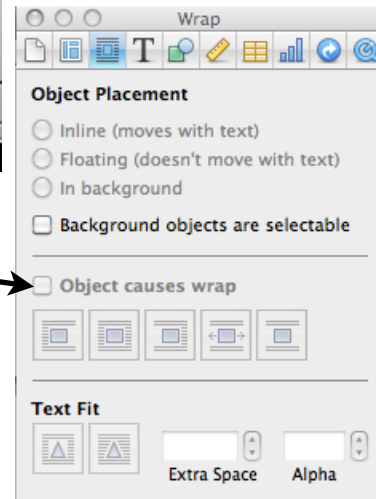
