

New Features

- A) The raised inside lip was removed, to use flat abs sheets for the cover. This does compromise water sealing somewhat, testing will be needed to determine viability.
- B) These holes are no longer designed to be threaded-instead, a bolt assembly will be used to give a larger clamping force, and ensure that this critical and well-used aspect of the project box lasts for years.
- C) The hole here is slotted, but not as long as the previous slot-assembly of the previous housing unit has given a better idea of our ideal location, and a smaller slot aids in waterproofing.
- D) The Gearbox rod brace has become a single unit, is capped on the end and has two setscrew holes to more securely hold the gearbox rod
- E) To aid in printing, 'mouse ears' have been added to all 4 corners. These help prevent warping.
