#### Writing Task 3

##### Option 1

- Create a political allegory that comments on a particular oppressive regime. (This can be a current or historical regime).
- This is to be in the form of a children's picture story book and should be electronically presented in PowerPoint.
- The story book should be accompanied by a 300-350 word written explanation that outlines such things as:
  1. Your chosen regime and who each character represents.
  2. The aspects of the regime you were trying to highlight and explore.
  3. The challenges you encountered creating this piece.

##### Option 2

- Create an annotated visual display.
- This is in the form of a poster and should be made up of pictures, words, symbols and anything else that students think appropriate to explore the theme of Power and Corruption.
- The poster should be accompanied by a 300-350 word written explanation that outlines such things as:
  1. How the various aspects of the poster explore the theme of Power and Corruption.
