Bear Information

Where do bears live?

Bears are furry mammals who live all over the world. They live in North America, Asia, Europe, and a few in South America. Bears can be found in forests, swamps, mountains, and grasslands. There are many types of bears. There are Grizzly Bears, Black Bears, Pandas, and Sun Bears.

What do bears look like?

Bears vary in size from 3.5 to 10 feet (1.1 to 3 m) long and weigh from 55 to 1,700 pounds (25 to 770 kg). The largest bear is the Polar Bear. Bear fur ranges in color from black to brown to blond to white.

How do bears behave?

Bears are solitary animals. Only a mother and cub live together for an extended time. Many bears are fast runners, excellent swimmers, and good climbers. Bears have a good sense of smell but poor eyesight. Many bears hibernate in caves or dens for the winter.

What do bears eat?

Bears are omnivores. They eat plants, leaves, fruits, berries, nuts, roots, honey, insects, and small mammals.
