Project Break-down Steps

Your Due Date	Steps
3/12	1. Complete pages 1-38 in "Creating a Legacy" Journal- at school.
3/12	2. Decide on an overall theme for your paper. This should relate to who you are and the journey you take to becoming who you want to be. (Ex. The Pieces of Me- How different pieces come together to create a whole).
3/26	3. Complete 4 hours of community service utilizing your talents and interests. Log your hours and have an adult supervisor sign your log each time.
2 genres due 3/12 2 genres due 3/19 2 genres due 3/26 2 genres due 4/2	<p>4. Start creating your genre pieces. You need 8 total. First brainstorm the genres you want to use. Remember you must include a play, a poem, an obituary or eulogy, and a letter or diary entry. Choose 3 more. Use the list of genres in your packet.</p> <p>My Genres</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">❖ Play❖ Poem❖ Obituary or Eulogy (circle one)❖ Letter or Diary Entry (circle one)❖ _____❖ _____❖ _____❖ _____ <p>The topic of your genre pieces should start first with who you are and progress to tell who you want to be in the future. Somewhere in the middle of your pieces should be a piece or two pieces where you reflect on your service. This should help inform you on who you want to be!</p>

4/12	5. Once your 8 genres are written, think about how you can tie them all together with a repetend. Examples are given in your packet. Remember my repetend was the repeating percentages at the top of the page. Once I got to my final piece, they added up to 100%. You should create your own repetend related to the theme you picked. Add your repetend to each genre piece.
4/13	6. Write the opening preface of your paper. This introduces the paper to the reader. Write it as a formal business letter.
4/13	7. Write the epilogue. Tell in a numbered list why you wrote each piece. This should follow the order of the paper.
4/13	<p>8. Create a title page for your paper. This should include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ❖ Title of Paper (probably the theme of your paper) ❖ Your Name ❖ Due Date (April 16th, 2010) ❖ Teacher Name (Miss Detrick) ❖ Course Name (Foundations of Literature and Composition) <p>Be creative with the presentation of the title page! Grab the reader's attention!</p>
4/14	9. Print and proofread your paper. Make sure you have someone else also proofread your paper. Preferably a parent! Make changes after you proof.
4/14	10. Put your paper in a logical order. We should see the progression from who you are to who you want to be. Put your service log in the back of your paper. This should be the last page.
4/14	11. Use your rubric to double-check that you've completed EVERYTHING!
In class	12. Complete pages 39-54 in your legacy journal.
