\_\_\_\_\_ (10 points) **Relevance of the title.** Write a one page response detailing the importance and significance of the title. Use passages (giving page numbers) from the book to support your answer.

\_\_\_\_\_ (10 points) **Editorial** based on a controversial issue in the book.

\_\_\_\_\_ (10 points) **Q & A** - Pretend you're interviewing a person from the book. Write your interview in question and answer format. A minimum of ten questions and a maximum of twenty questions please.

\_\_\_\_\_ (10 points) Write a one minute **radio advertisement** persuading the public why they should buy and read this book. **OR** As a literary agent, **write a letter to the publishing company** designed to persuade them to publish this book.

\_\_\_\_\_ (10 points) **Top 10 List** - list ten things you learned from this book.

\_\_\_\_\_ (10 points) Write a **letter to the author**.

\_\_\_\_\_ (10 points) Write a **song, poem or rap** about the book.

\_\_\_\_\_ (10 points) Choose your **favorite passage** from the book. Copy it down and discuss what you found appealing about it. Write a collective response.

\_\_\_\_\_ (10 points) **Compare and contrast** the book with another you have read. (individual score)
