


Colour One Part of a Grayscale Picture

1. Open Photoshop CS5
2. Open a photo of your choice or use the Flowers photo
3. Create a duplicate of the photo
4. From the *Image* menu, select *Adjustments*. From the submenu, select *Desaturate*.

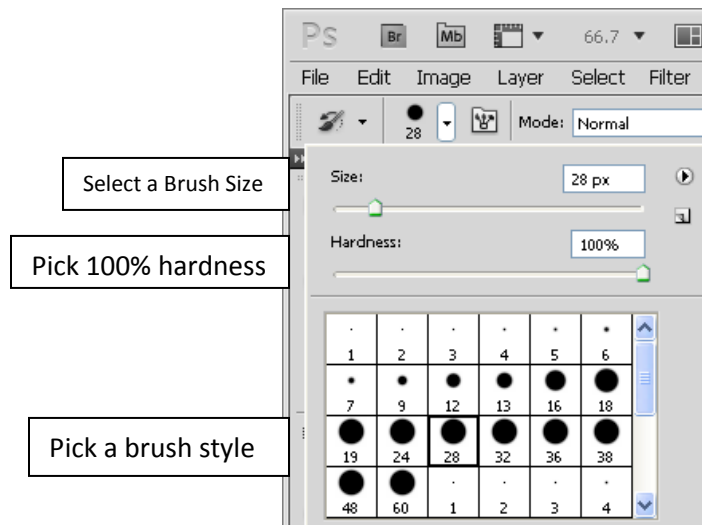
5. Click the History brush tool on the Toolbox 

6. A) Click the Brush Preset picker on the Options Bar 

B) To select a brush style, click the Brush Preset picker menu 

C) Select Basic Brushes from the list. When asked to replace the current brushes, click OK.

D) Set the Brush Styles Options:



7. Click and drag the brush over the part of the picture you want coloured

HINTS:

- use the Zoom tool to magnify the area
- use a small brush size to outline the shape then increase the brush size to fill with colour

8. Save the picture
