

Dear Parent,

Science and Modern Languages are organising a trip to France, which is planned for next June for students who are in the third and fifth year.

The trip to Paris will follow a Scientific Programme that will complement the Standard Grade and Higher courses that our pupils are following. The trip will include excursions to interactive Science Museums, Paris sewers and Botanic Gardens, as well as visits to famous tourist spots such as the Eiffel Tower, Arc de Triomphe and the river Seine. This trip will give pupils the opportunity to strengthen their Science knowledge, gain experience of speaking French and develop an understanding of Parisian culture. Pupils will be transported around the city by coach, their accommodations will be in an International House, above Youth Hostel standard, and their meals will be taken both in the accommodation and at local restaurants.

The amount to be paid by each student will be a maximum of £300 and there will be a big subsidy available to cover the balance. A deposit of £30 will be payable by the end of September.

I would recommend this trip for your child and with your permission will put his/her name forward on the excursion list.
