

My reading strategy is the Frayer Model. This strategy can be used as a before, during or after strategy. This strategy has students analyze words or concepts to check their understanding. This strategy can help students learn and better understand vocabulary and key concepts.

The teacher will have students get with a partner and hand out a worksheet for the students to complete as a before reading strategy. The teacher will then explain what the students are supposed to do and give them 4-5 minutes to minutes to complete the worksheet. As the students work, the teacher will walk around the room to monitor students. The teacher will then ask the students to share their ideas about the new concept with the rest of the class. Once we have discussed the students ideas, the teacher will go into the lesson for the day.
