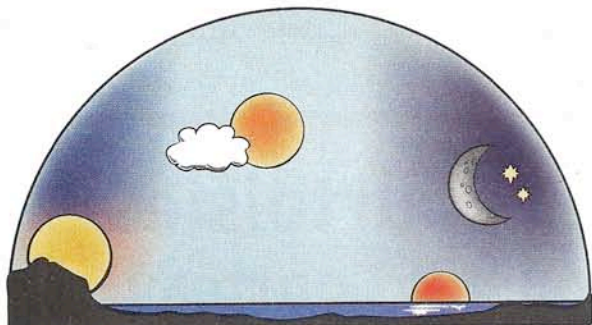


Vocabulaire

A traditional warm French greeting is to give up to four kisses, alternating between the right and left cheek.

When you say hello to an adult, use the formal greeting: *Bonjour, Madame!* or *Bonjour, Monsieur!* Add the person's last name if you know it: *Bonjour, Madame Pilorget!* *Salut*, an informal and casual greeting, is usually said to a friend: *Salut, Pierre!*

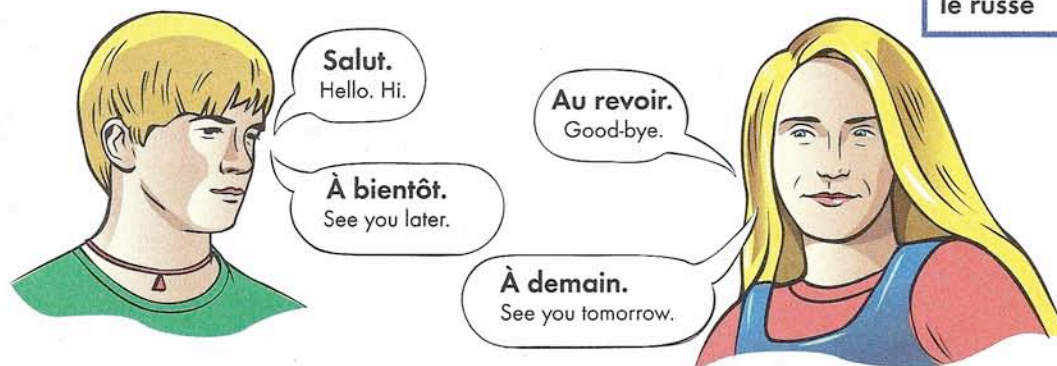
When meeting someone, a girl says *Enchantée* (spelled with an extra "e"), which means "I'm delighted to meet you."

Another expression, *Avec plaisir*, means "I'm pleased to meet you."

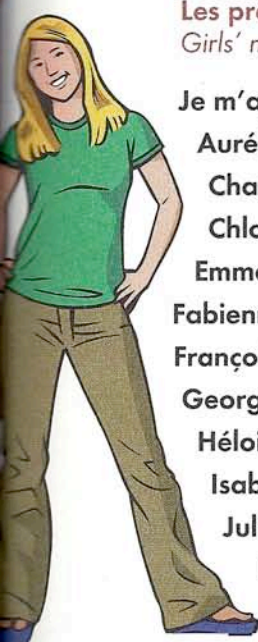
The term *Mademoiselle* (Miss) refers generally to a young girl, while *Madame* is used to address any woman, regardless of marital status.
