

## I am a famous French-speaking Olympian

As you may imagine, there have been many famous French-speaking Olympic athletes over the last century. Your job is to IDENTIFY an athlete, take on his or her identity, and present yourself to the class. Your research should include:

Once you have found out the basics, begin crafting your project.

1. You will be speaking using the memorized script you have written.
2. You may create a Power-Point to go along with it, for example, showing us pictures of you during the Olympic Games, showing us how your sport is played, etc.
3. Alternatively, you can hold cards up to describe things applicable to your sporting event, or about your life and you will dress closely to the style of your athlete by sport or by time-period.
4. Each person shall present, making eye contact, speaking fluidly and audibly to the class audience.

A grading rubric is attached for you to plan your project. This rubric covers: research, writing, speaking, and memorization. Please plan accordingly!

You will have Friday to work in the Computer lab to do research for your project, and Monday to work on the writing of your script. Presentations will begin on Wednesday. Bonne Chance!
