

Rainbow Words

Write each of your spelling words with a pencil. Then trace over each word three times, using a **different** color **each** time. Trace neatly, and you will see a funky **rainbow**!

Super Sentences

Use **each** of your spelling words in a sentence. Make sure you write detailed sentences, and underline the spelling word in **each** sentence. Use one spelling word per sentence.

Example: Mrs. Estes is a huge fan of chocolate, and she eats a little of it every day!

ABC Order

Write your spelling words in alphabetical order.

Then write your words in reverse alphabetical order!

Spelling Stairs

Write each spelling word. Below **each** word, write it again like a staircase.

Examples:	<u>books</u>	<u>ruler</u>
	b	r
	bo	ru
	boo	rul
	book	rule
	books	ruler

3-D Words

P

Get a plastic mat, and choose one **color** of Play-Doh. Use the Play-Doh to create **each** of your spelling words. Have a friend check your words to make sure they are spelled correctly.

Secret Agent Words

Write the alphabet vertically, and number the letters from 1-26.

Example: a=1

b=2

c=3

d=4

e=5, etc.

Write your spelling words, and convert your words to a "secret" number code. Write the code next to each word.

Choo-Choo Words

Write your entire list of spelling words end-to-end as one long word (like a train). Use a different color for each of your spelling words.

Example: **slidebookruler**candy

match-up

Write each of your words on **two** different pieces of scrap paper. Turn **all** the cards face down, and mix them up. Lay out your cards like you do in other memory games. Flip over **two** cards at a time. **Read** each card aloud softly as you flip them over. If you make a match, **place** the cards to the side. If you don't make a match, flip them back over, and **keep trying!**

Story, Story

Write a short story using **ALL** of your spelling words. Please make sure you underline each of your spelling words in the paragraph.

Bubble Up!

Write your spelling words using **bubble** letters. After writing your words, **color** them in with a crayon or colored pencil.

3 Times Each

Write each of your spelling words **three** times. You may use a pencil, pen, crayon, **colored** pencil, marker, or any combination of writing implements available!

Acrostic Poem

Choose 5 of your spelling words, and write an acrostic poem for each word. You may also illustrate your poem, if you have time.

Example:

B	uried under blankets
O	pening the pages
O	blivious to everyone around me
K	illing time the best way possible!

Adding My Words

Each letter has a value.

Consonants are worth 5 points.

Vowels are worth 10 points.

Write your spelling words. Then add up the value of each of them.

Example:

said: $5 + 10 + 10 + 5 = 20$ points

Sign Your Words

Use the sign language sheet to sign your spelling words to a friend. Make sure you give them your list, so they can check that you are spelling them correctly!



This means "I love you".

UPPER & lower

Write your spelling words two times each.

First, write each word in **UPPERCASE** letters.

Second, write each word in **lowercase** letters

Example: SLIDE slide

Across AND

Write each of your spelling words **across** and then **down** (sharing the first letter).

Example: candy

a

n

d

y



Type 'Em

Type your spelling words on the computer. Use a different font for each word. Once you're done, print out your words, trim them, and glue them into your WS notebook.

Word Search

Make a word search puzzle using your words. Go to www.puzzlemaker.com, give your word search a title, and type in your spelling words. Print out your word search & find your words. Once you've found all your words, trim the word search, and glue it into your WS notebook.

Word Connect

Grab a sheet of graph paper. Try to find a way to make all of your spelling words connect.

Trim your work, and glue it into your WS notebook.

Example:

Bottle Cap Switcheroo

Write your spelling words in your WS notebook. Use bottle caps to spell out each of your spelling words. Move the bottle caps around to help you spell words that are hidden within each of your words. Try to find at least two hidden words in each of your spelling words.

Example: slide (side, lie, lid, led, etc.)

If you cannot make any new words, write a "?" next to the spelling word. That will let me know you couldn't find any words.

Stamp It Up!

Using alphabet stamps, **stamp** each of your spelling words in your WS notebook.

LETTER TILES

Write your spelling words in your WS notebook. Use letter tiles to **spell** out each of your spelling words. Move the tiles around to help you spell words that are hidden **within** each of your words. Try to find at least **two** hidden words in each of your spelling words.

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Grammar Connection

Write down your spelling words.
Use the **dictionary** to find its part of speech, and write it next to the word.

Example: chocolate (noun)

Missing V _ w _ ls

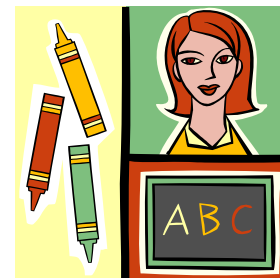

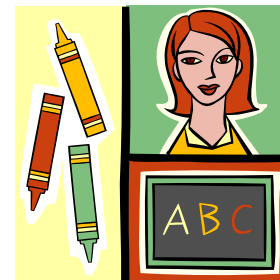
