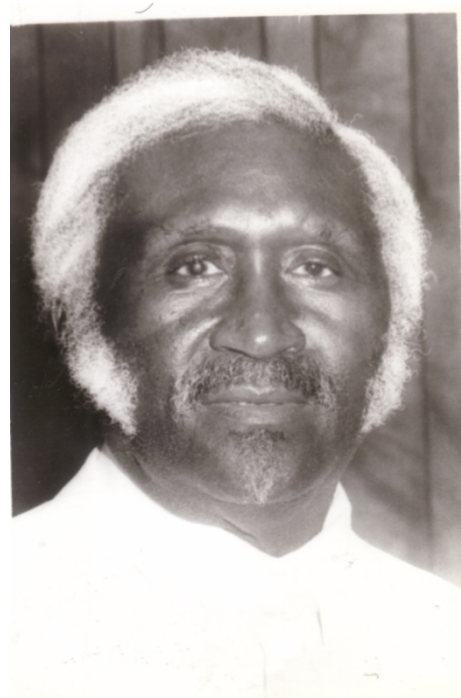

In September of 1964 the articles of incorporation for the Beth Eden Baptist Church were filed. Its stated purpose was to "buy, sell, mortgage hold and own land upon which to erect church buildings, Sunday School buildings and other appropriate structures in which to worship God and in which to preach and teach the religion of our Lord, Jesus Christ according to the faith and practices of a Missionary Baptist Church.."

The registered agents for the church were Leandrew Warren and the Reverend C.L. Simmons of West Monroe. The location of the church was domiciled at 1800 Milhaven Road in Monroe, La.

The original incorporators of the church were: Andrew Smith, Henry Porter, vice-chairman; F.H. Harrell, secretary-treasurer; Leandrew Warren, chairman; Elijah Richardson, and the Reverend C.L. Simmons.
