Virtual Tour Final Project

Upon **completion** of the work placement, CWEX students are required to do a final project which will then be presented to the rest of the class. You will be creating a Virtual Tour of your placement. This might be tricky without actual pictures.... This is why we are all on an even playing field. It is your job to create a presentation talking not about the placement alone, but how you have improved your skills as an effective worker.

You will be choosing what presentation tool you will be using to share your final thoughts about your placement and what you have learned about during your workplace journey. You must include images, videos and/or descriptions of the following:

- a. Introduction to project (name, class, school)
- b. name of placement
- c. services provided by your placement
- d. your general duties
- e. transferable skills used and developed at the placement
- f. most positive experience(s) - explain
- g. most challenging experience - explain
- h. your strength(s) as a worker - explain
- i. one weakness as a worker - explain
- j. what you learned about yourself and the work world at the placement

It is KEY to remember you are taking us on a tour of your journey as a worker. You have a lot of information (or you should have) in your journals that can assist you in this process.

The final project must be presented to the rest of the class, as I believe being able to present helps you during an interview. Remember this project not only demonstrates how you have taken the first steps to be an effective employee and learned at the work placement, but also is intended to inform students about other occupational areas.

Your presentation should be between **5 -7 minutes** long. After the presentation, there will be a required question and answer period.
