

NEGRO TAKEN AS PLOT SUSPECT IN RACE RIOTS

Dr. Leroy N. Bundy, a Negro dentist of East St. Louis, was arrested yesterday in Cleveland, O., after a wide search by Adj. Gen. Frank S. Dickson and the police of East St. Louis, and accused of complicity in connection with the shooting of two detectives which led to the riots last month in which many were killed and Negroes driven from the city.

Bundy is alleged to have been seen to display large sums of money provided for the purpose of aiding in the importation of Negro labor and to organize them to prevent their being driven away. It is alleged the mob of Negroes who attacked the police on the first night of the trouble was incited to some sort of resistance.

It is for the deaths of the two policemen that Bundy has been sought. The police expect a statement showing the extent of the conspiracy to import Negroes, and Bundy will be questioned to this end. Large employers of labor are believed to have used Bundy as their agent.
