

Acadia National Park

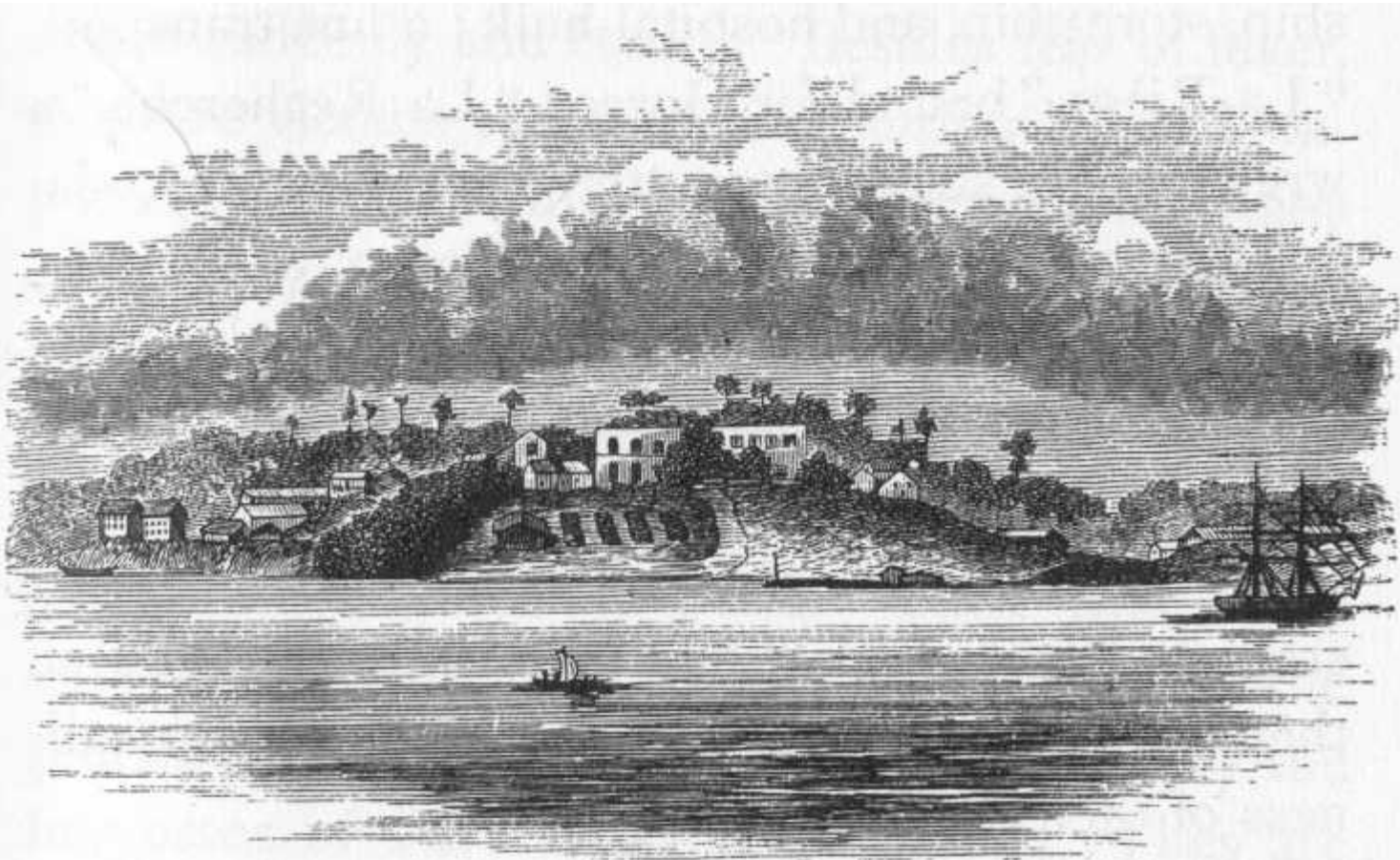
Acadia National Park is located in Maine on Mount Desert Island.



Created by President Woodrow Wilson in 1919 and got enlarged in 1921. It was the first national park east of the Mississippi River.

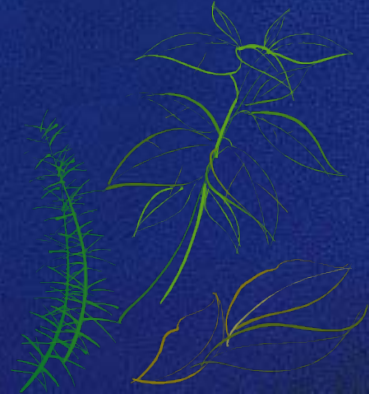
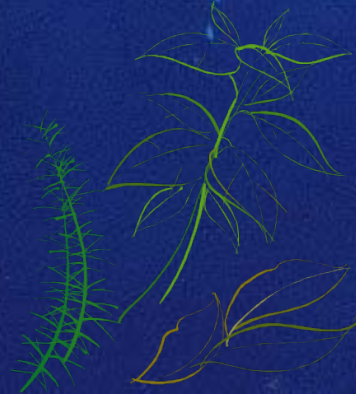
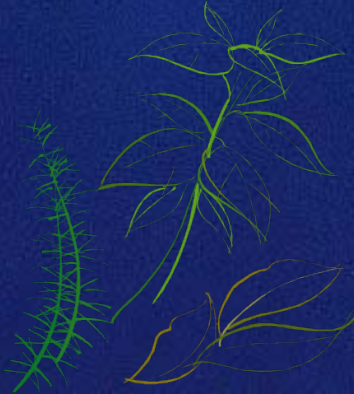


Named after a French

Peregrine Falcon

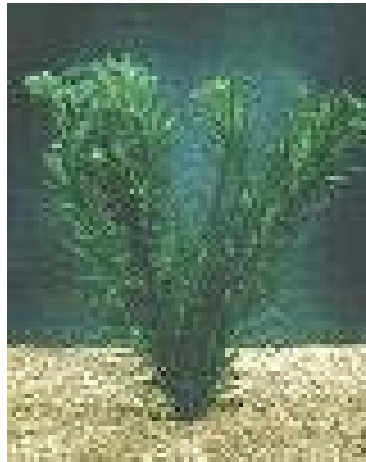

Mississippi River.

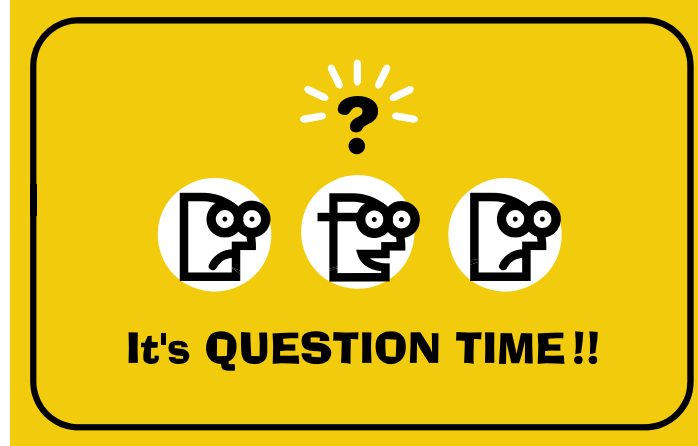
Specialties

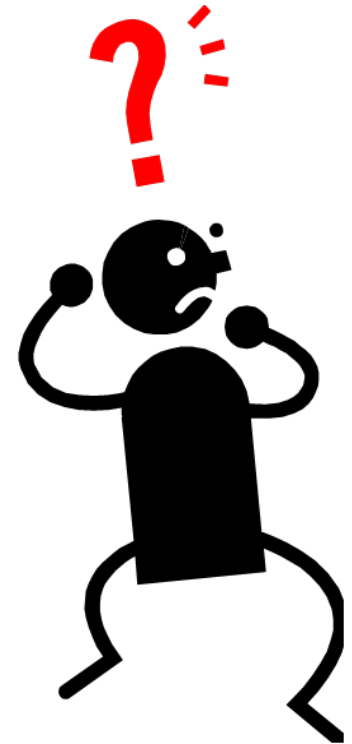
