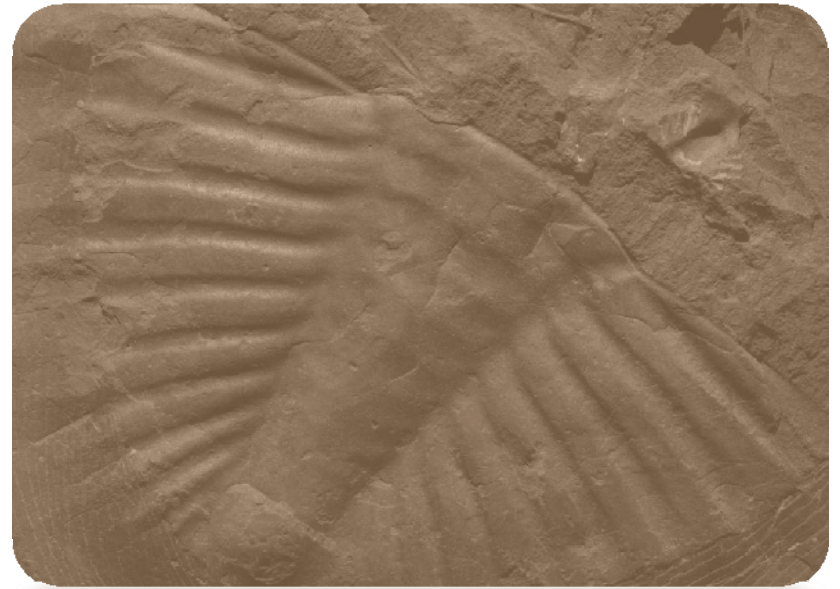

- Wolf

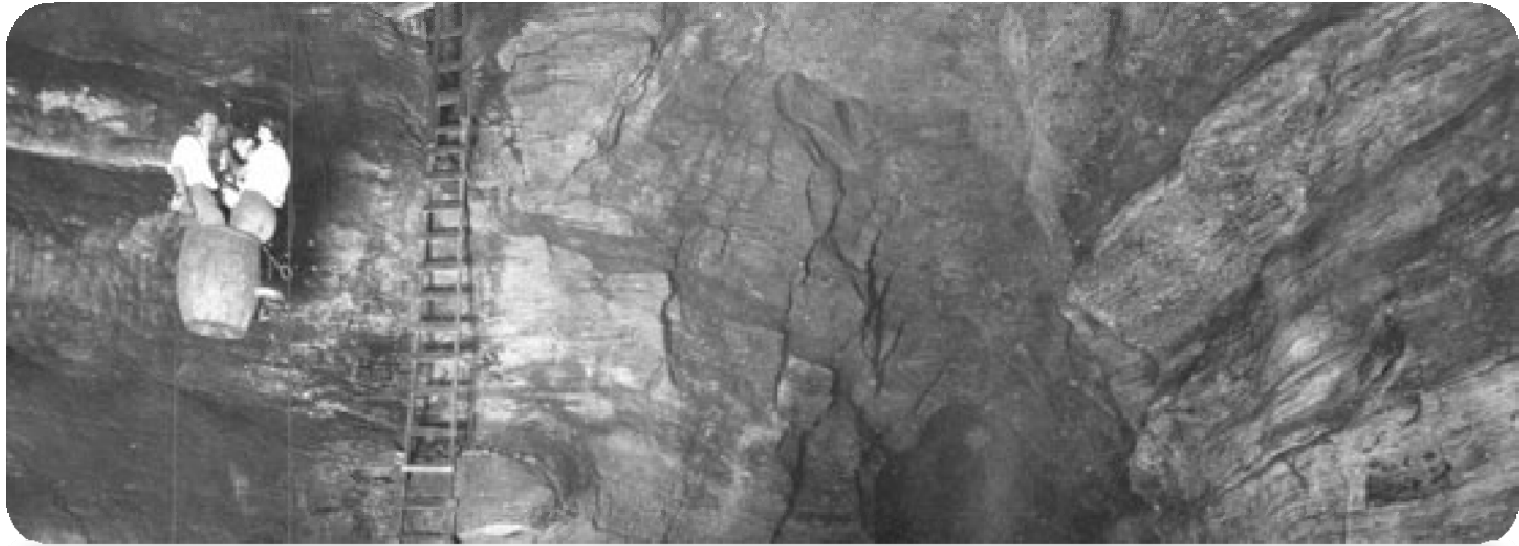


Indians have visited here long ago. Their writing has been found on the mouths of caves' walls.

Carlsbad Caverns is made up of limestone caverns. If the sun touches the inside of caverns it makes them very colorful.
