Some of the mammals that live at Zion are the mule deer and the horse(mustang) because it is the perfect habitat for them.





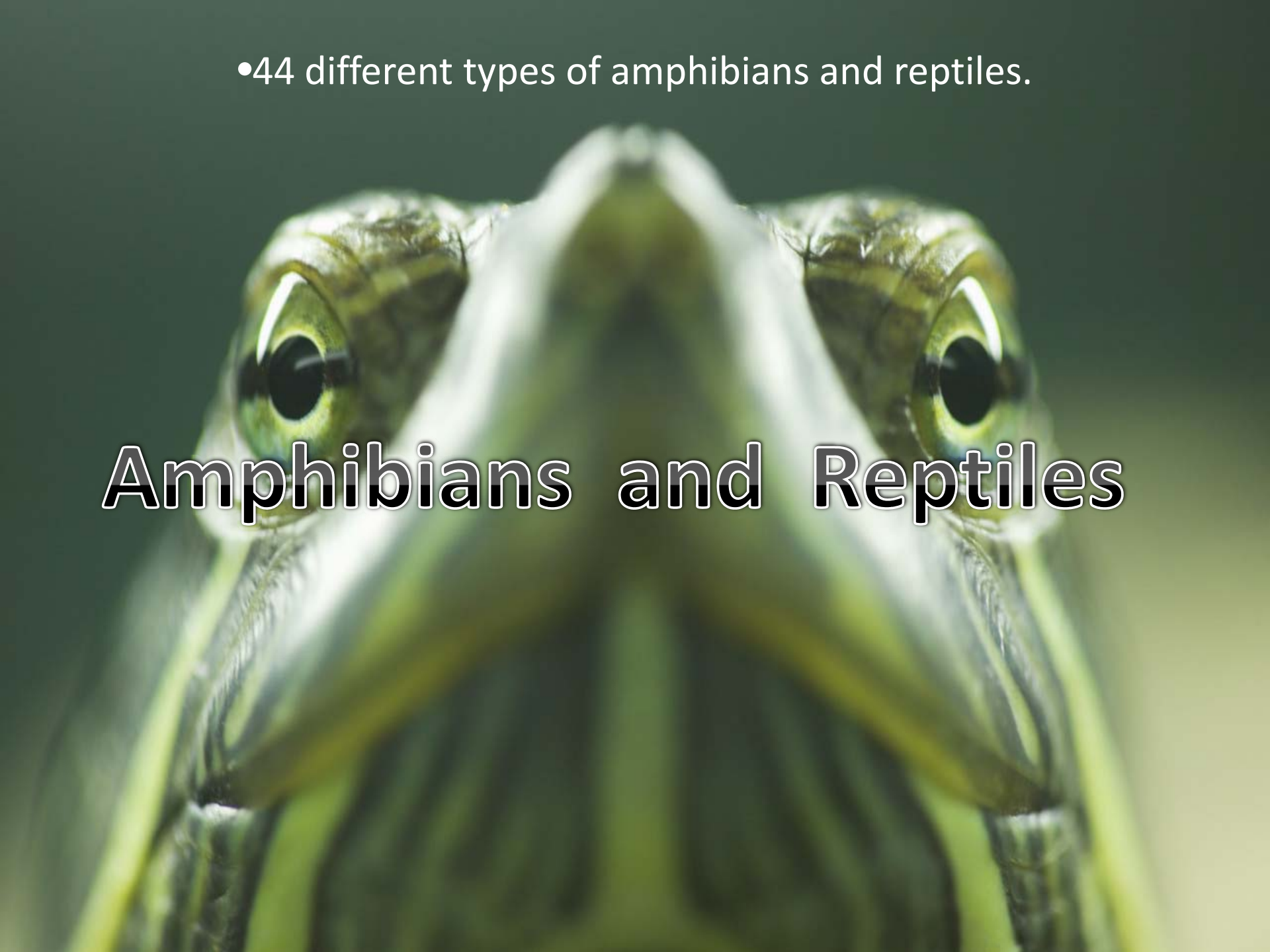
