## Project notes

## Instructions - Character Profile

- **Explain** how those aspects influence the characters' interactions with other characters and elements of the plot, including resolution of the major conflict.
- **Complete** the template provided using your best writing skills.

## Peer Conference

- When you are finished with your rough draft please choose two other students to peer edit your character profile.
- Ask the readers to give you advice to make your writing better and have them edit the character profile for conventions.
- Be sure to follow the format discussed in class when posting to your Book Blog.

## Extra Notes

- After publishing on your Book Blog remember to find a picture of the cover of the book and insert that into your blog.
- Include a link for your audience to purchase the book after reading your character profile.
