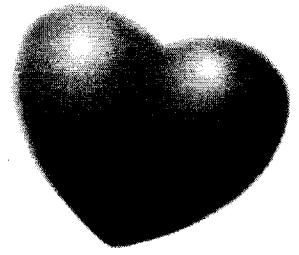


February Book Project



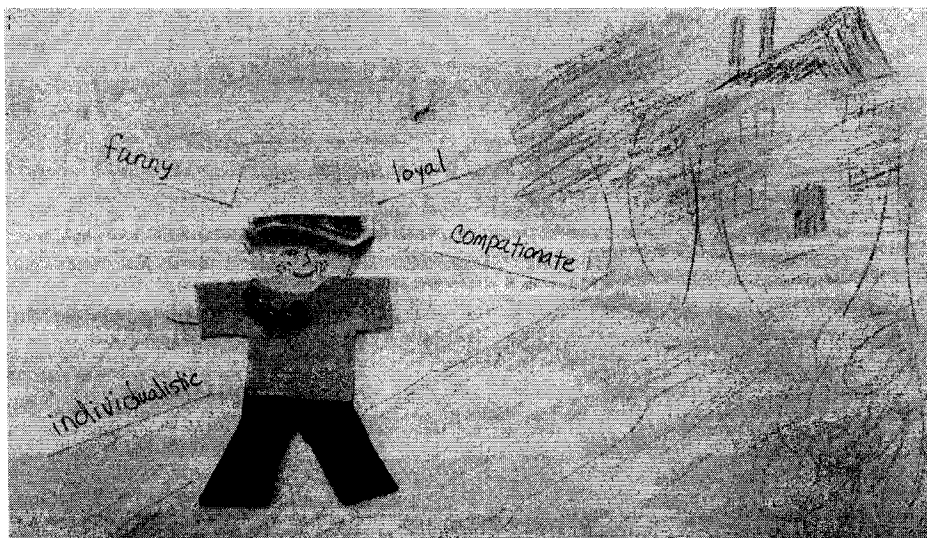
1. Choose a book to read that is at least 120 pages long.
2. As you read your book, complete the Reading Log each time you read.
3. Choose an important character in your book. It does not have to be the main character, but it does need to be a character that was important to the story.

Cut out the paper doll and dress it like the important character you have chosen from your book. You may “dress” the paper doll in cloth, paper, or some other material. Do not just color the paper doll.

4. Decide on four (4) characteristics that would describe your character. (These should NOT be physical characteristics, such as tall.) Complete the Character Characteristics paper to support the characteristics.
5. On the piece of white construction paper, draw a scene from your book, and glue your paper doll on the scene. Write the four characteristics you chose on the four white strips of paper and glue them on the picture also.
