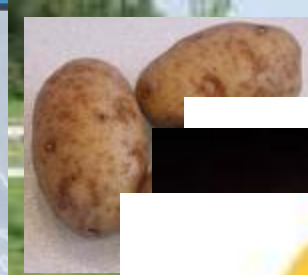

# Why Columbian?

- **Global Transfer of Goods, plants, animals and disease during the colonizing of the Americas**
- T-chart the effects of the exchange
- **Mercantilism system**
  - **Economy based on getting valuable items (sugar, gold, tobacco)**
  - **Colonies are created to get raw materials**
  - **Raw material are sent back to mother country**

# Long Term Impact

## • Positives

- More farming options (potatoes for Ireland's poor soil or oxen to help natives plow)
- Balanced Diets
  - Proteins, carbs...
- Population Increase (For Europeans)
- Increase Wealth
  - New business opportunities

## • Negatives

- Dependence on single food source (Ire)
- Forced and Volunteer migration (colonization)
- Slavery
- Rapid spread of Globe Diseases
