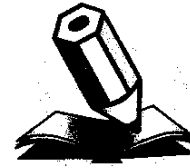

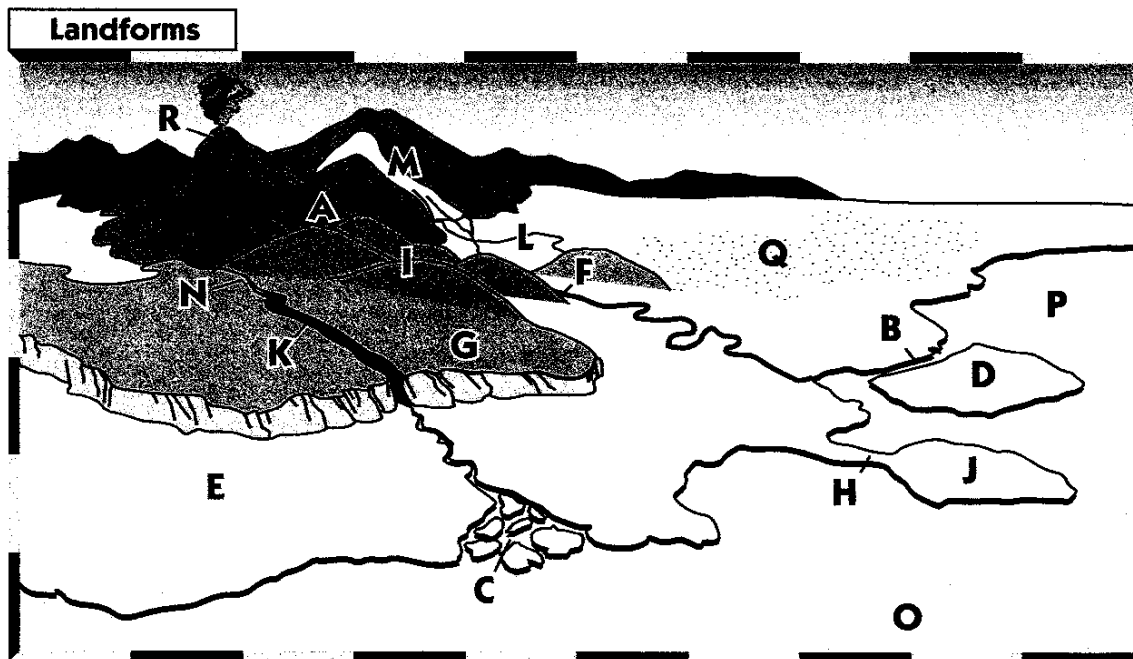
Identifying Landforms
