Church Construction:

1. All stained glass windows are from the previous church that served Immanuel from 1890 – 1962. **Which image is your favorite? Why?**

Organ: *Located in the balcony*

2. Immanuel's organ consists of 2,270 pipes. They play various pitches, depending on the length, and have various sounds. **Which one do you like the best? Why?**

Nave: *Place where congregation is seated. Nave – Navy – Ship – Noah's Ark.*

3. **How does God use Noah's Ark to show love to his people?**

Chancel: *Place where the Altar and pulpit are located*

4. Did you notice that Jesus, while suffering on the cross, is blessing us? The two stones that support the altar represent the New and Old Testament. **There are seven candles on the altar. Please note one way, or more, that seven is an important number in the Bible.**

Baptismal Font:

5. Do you see the 3 candles? Do they remind you of the words of Baptism..."I Baptize you in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit". One candle, for each person of the Trinity. **Look closely at the baptismal font. What creature do you see? How does this point to baptism?**
