


Counting for Band


Eighth Rest → *An eighth rest receives the same number of counts that an eighth note would receive*


1+ 2+ 3+ 4 + 1 + 2 + 3 + 4+


Helpful Hints:


In  time, each full measure needs to have the following (1+2+3+4+)

When the low number of a Time Signature is 4, the following is true:

 = 4 counts (1+2+3+4+) - in 4/4 time it fills the "whole" measure

 = 2 counts (1+2+) - in 4/4 time it fills "half" the measure

 = 1 count (1+) - in 4/4 time it fills "one quarter" of the measure

 = 0.5 counts (1) - in 4/4 time, you need 8 eighth notes to fill the measure
