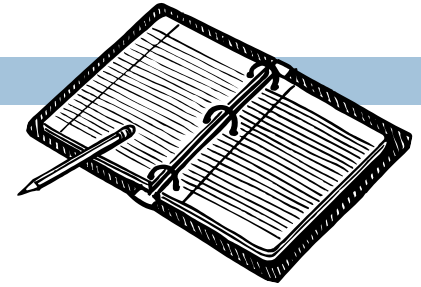


Expectations

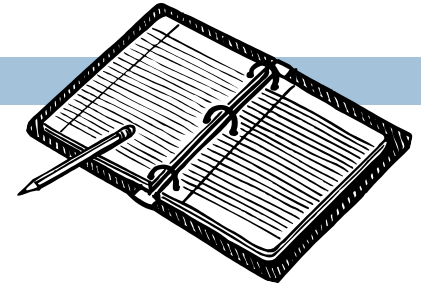
