Friday	<i>Students will understand new vocabulary and use it when reading and writing; use context to determine meaning and use a dictionary.</i> Begin working on Lesson 5 Vocabulary	Read SSR book for 20 minutes at home (as needed) Lesson 5 packet due next Friday
