Service: Work preformed to satisfy a want or need. A service is not MAKING something, but instead DOING something.

Services



Services are jobs that people do to help other people. Service workers do not make things. Instead, they work to help other people. A teacher helps students to learn. A doctor helps people to get well. People who fix broken cars do a service, too. They help people to get their car running again.

People who make or grow things are not service workers. They are called goods workers.

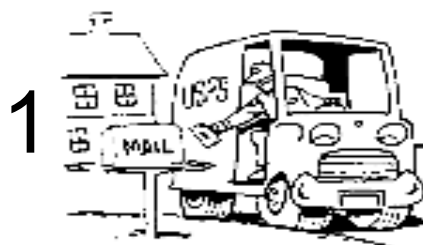
