**1. The Annunciation**

The angel tells Mary that she is to be the Mother of God

**2. The Visitation**

Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth

**3. The Birth of Jesus-The Nativity**

Jesus is born in Bethlehem

**4. The Presentation of Jesus in the temple**

Mary and Joseph take the baby Jesus to the Temple for the first time

**5. The Finding in the Temple**

Mary and Joseph find Jesus talking to the elders

**The Sorrowful Mysteries** (prayed on Tuesdays and Fridays)

**1. The Agony in the Garden**

Jesus prays on the night before his death

**2. The Scourging at the Pillar**

Jesus is beaten

**3. The Crowning with Thorns**

The people make fun of the kingship of Jesus

**4. The Carrying of the Cross**

Jesus carries his cross to Calvary

**5. The Crucifixion**

Jesus dies on the cross

## **The Glorious Mysteries      (Prayed on Sundays and Wednesdays)**

### **1. The Resurrection**

Jesus is raised from the dead

### **2. The Ascension**

Jesus returns to his Father

### **3. The Coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost**

The followers of Jesus receive the gift of the Holy Spirit

### **4. The Assumption of Mary**

Mary is taken, body and soul, into heaven

### **5. The Crowning of Mary as the Queen of Heaven**

Mary is crowned Queen of Heaven and Earth

## **The Luminous Mysteries      (Prayed on Thursdays)**

### **1. The Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan**

Jesus is baptized

### **2. The Wedding at Cana**

Jesus turns the water into wine

### **3. The Proclamation of the Kingdom of God**

Jesus proclaims the coming of the Kingdom of God

### **4. The Transfiguration**

Jesus is changed-His face shone like the sun and his clothes became white as light

### **5. The Institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper**

Jesus proclaimed “Take and eat; this is My body”
