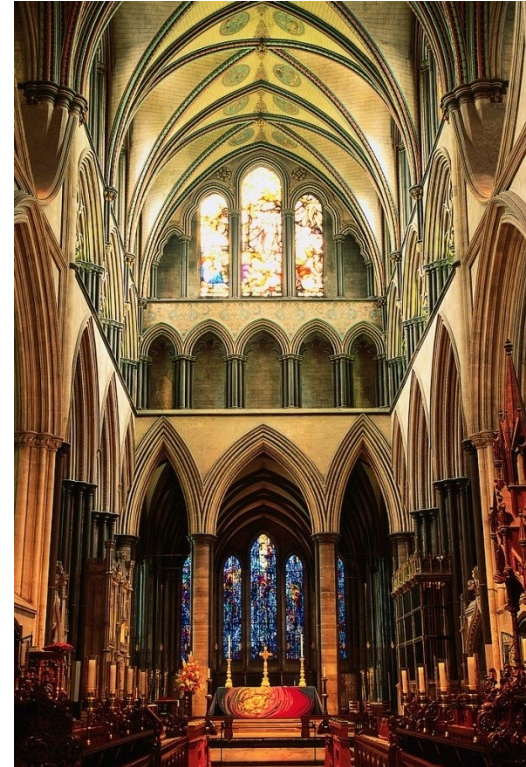
Chapter 2

Parts of the Mass

- **Liturgy of the Word**
 - Christ is present
 - God's word from the Bible
- **Liturgy of the Eucharist**
 - Christ is present
 - Through the Holy Spirit
 - Bread and Wine become
 - Body and Blood of Christ



The Last Supper

- Took place on Holy Thursday
- Jesus gave us the Eucharist
- Jesus asked us to share this meal often
- Priest consecrated (**made holy**) the bread and wine

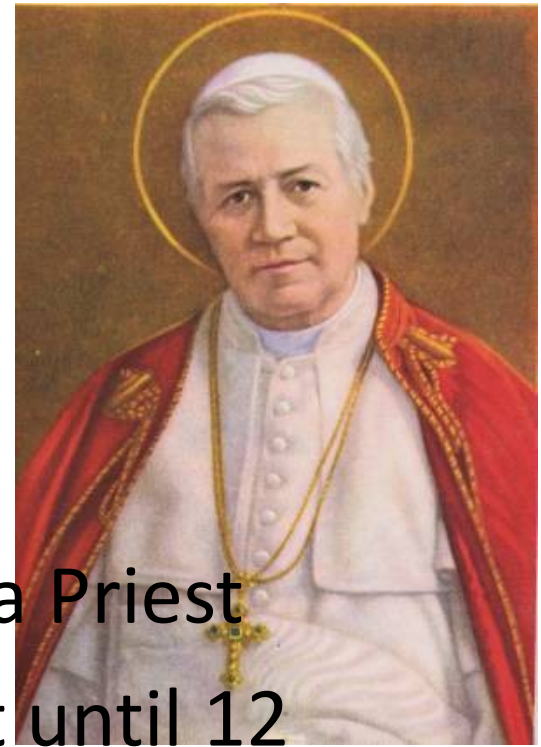
- **Mass**
- Celebration of the Eucharist is called the Mass. We share the Life, Death, and Resurrection of Christ.
- **Liturgy of the Word**
- Part of the Mass in which we hear the Word of God in the Scriptures.
- **Liturgy of the Eucharist**
- Part of the Mass in which the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of Christ.

- We celebrate God's goodness at the mass
- Priest
 - Unites us with God
 - Remember the sacrifice Jesus made for us
- All the prayers and actions make up a complete Mass



Saint Pius X

- Giuseppe Sarto
 - Grew up in Northern Italy
 - Part of a large family
- God was calling to him to become a Priest
- Giuseppe was upset he had to wait until 12 years old to receive the Holy Eucharist
- At the seminary
 - Read “Let the children come to Me”
 - Wanted to help children receive communion earlier in life



- Worked in poor parishes
- Became a Bishop
- 1903 became Pope
 - Chose the name Pius X
 - Encouraged a change
 - Children should receive Communion as young as 7
- Know as the Pope who loved the Eucharist
- Feast day
 - August 21
